Fort Carson to conduct incident response exercise, noise and smoke expected

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Safety teams from both Butts Army Heliport and the 4th Combat Aviation Brigade will conduct an incident response training exercise June 4 at 10 a.m. on post.

The exercise will simulate an incident at the heliport, testing critical response capabilities and inter-agency communication between civilian and military response units.

The intent of the exercise is to test units' abilities to effectively respond to an incident, ensuring future incident management success. An increase in machine-generated smoke and noise can be expected.

This annual exercise is expected to last approximately two hours. The community is asked not to contact emergency services for smoke, fire and emergency response activities at Butts Army Heliport during this time.
