Media Opportunity Construction begins on new Soldier-Family housing

FORT CARSON, Colo. — Fort Carson and Balfour Beatty Communities will host a ceremony to commence the first phase of a multi-phase construction project of new housing Monday, Aug. 5 at noon.

Horizontal site work is complete and underground utilities are installed. The foundation for the Arapahoe Village on-post housing has been set and is ready for vertical construction.

The initial phase will introduce 56 new residential units, including 3- and 4-bedroom townhomes, with one unit specifically designed to meet ADA compliance standards. The complex will be located near Gate 2 and directly south of Mountainside Elementary School.

This construction kick-off ceremony will include the standing of the first framed wall, stood up by U.S. Army Installation Management Command-Readiness, division and garrison leadership
