EACH open house highlights brain injury awareness

FORT CARSON, Colo. — The Fort Carson Intrepid Spirit Center will host an open house on March 21 from noon to 1 p.m., in support of the Defense Health Agency's Brain Injury Awareness Month campaign.

The Fort Carson Intrepid Spirit Center is a state-of-the-art treatment facility dedicated to the assessment and care of concussions and other forms of Brain Injuries.

The ISC's mission is to protect, treat, and optimize warfighter brain health. The ISC Team consists of medical, rehabilitation, and behavioral health experts in treating mild traumatic brain injury.

Visitors will learn about the ISC's innovative treatments, meet its team of experts, and discover how the center supports service members with a history of brain injuries using full-spectrum treatment options, to include art and music therapy.

The intent of the open house is to increase awareness about the center's programs. This event is open to all military ID cardholders.
