Media Opportunity 2nd SBCT Soldiers return home, brigade uncases colors

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 2nd Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, will uncase the brigade colors in a ceremony Tuesday, at the William "Bill" Reed Special Event Center at 8 a.m.

Col. Keith W. Benedict and Command Sgt. Maj. Joseph Cobb, the command team for the 2nd SBCT, 4th Inf. Div., will uncase the brigade flag and battle streamers symbolizing the return of the headquarters element to Fort Carson.

Elements of 2nd SBCT deployed last spring to U.S. Pacific Command's area of operations as part of a regular rotation of forces to support the United States' commitment to the Republic of Korea.

The 2nd SBCT was assigned to the 8th Army Headquarters in Korea and the 'Mountain Warriors' acted as the primary ground element in missions to improve security and cooperation with partner militaries and increase regional stability.
