Medical Holdover Flow Chart- Deployment

Revised January 2010

Evacuated
RC soldier

Can soldier
RTD w/in 60 days
AND have at least 120
Days left on mob orders
Beyond RTD date?

YES

Assign to WTU
And remain on AD UP USC 12302

Soldier will remain assigned to WTU until
medical determination made concerning RTD,
entry into the CBWTU program, REFRAD,
retirement or discharge

NO

Reassign to WTU UP 10 USC 12301(h)

- Request orders from HRC
- Orders packet will include MRP application, DA 4187; DA 3349, copy individual mob orders w/all amendments and Medical Provider statement
- HRC will publish **179 day** orders UP 10 USC 12301(h)
- Requests for extensions will be submitted to HRC NLT 45 days prior to end date of orders

Proceed with medical evaluation and treatment until optimal medical care is reached and Soldier is RTD or processed through PDES

to remain on AD for

- *Soldier signs declination letter
- *DEMOB site completes Medical Treatment Letter of Authorization/Instruction
- *Ensure copy of complete LODs and all medical documentation given to soldier for follow-up care after REFRAD
- *Soldier coordinates with chain of command for other possible benefits (INCAP, VA, TRICARE)

Soldier cleared
for REFRAD

When a medical determination is
made to RTD a soldier, the
WTU will notify HRC

HRC will direct the
WTU and Transition Center
to REFRAD Soldier &
return to Reserve status
