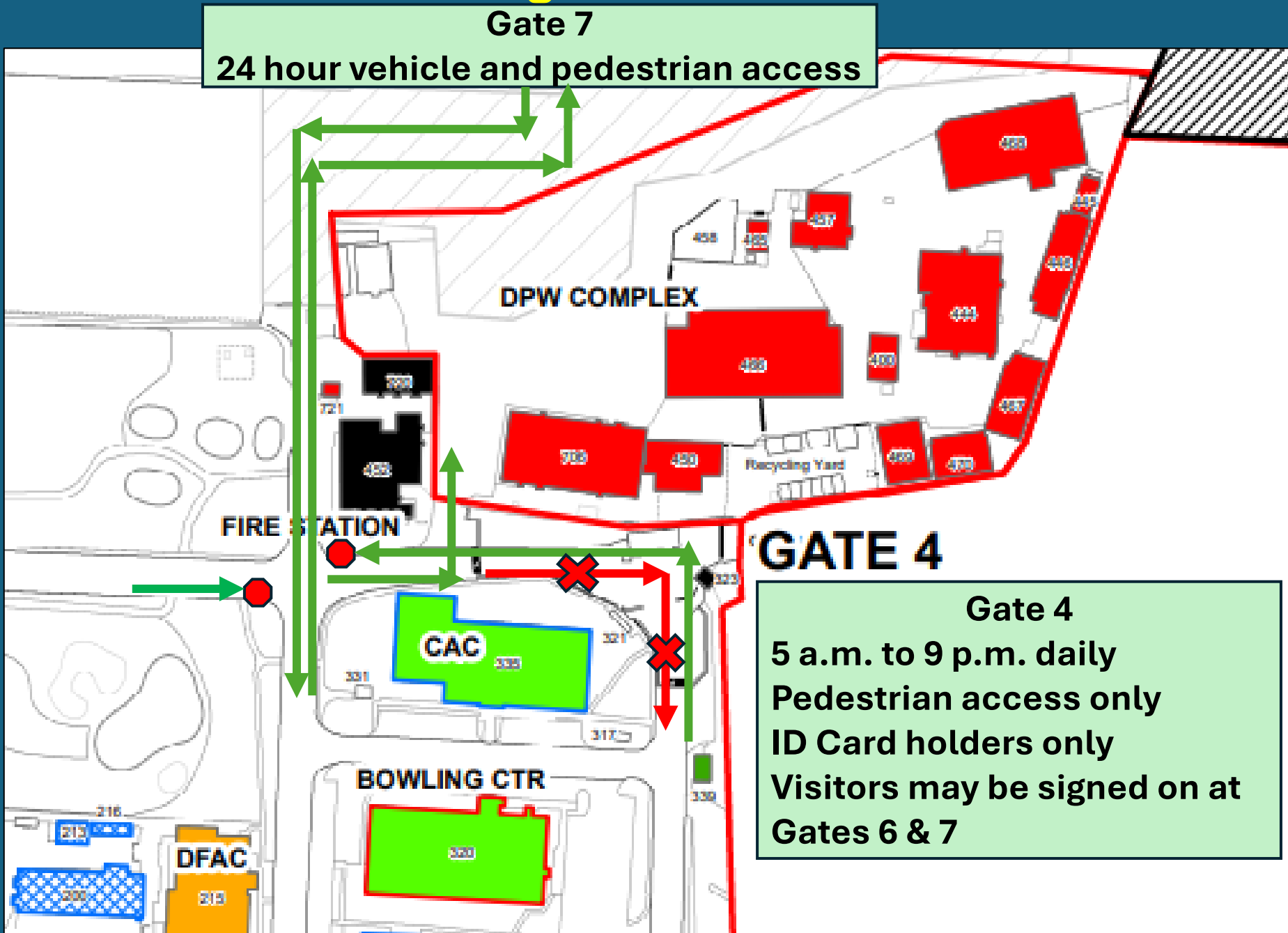

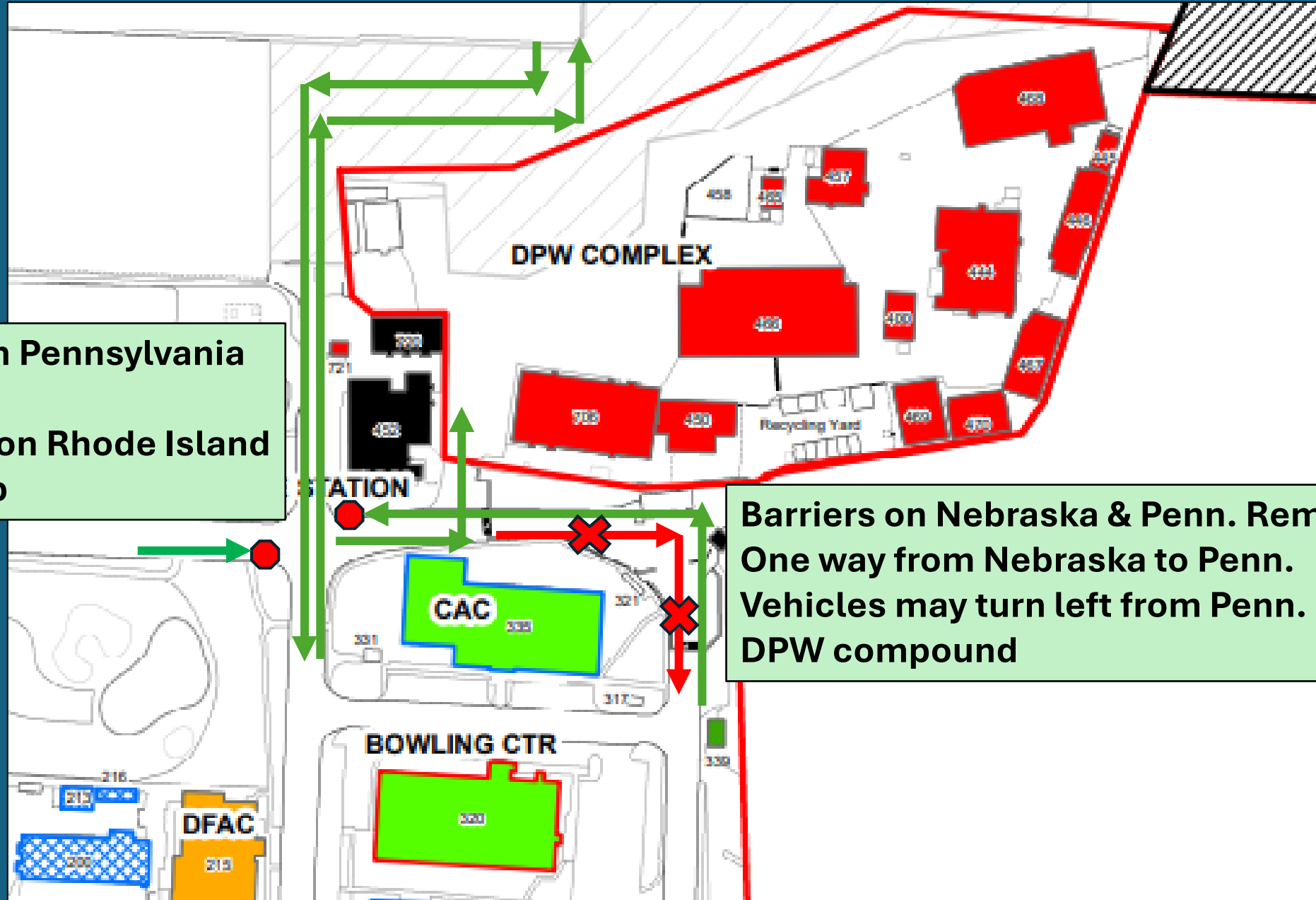
Gate & Traffic Changes Effective December 15th

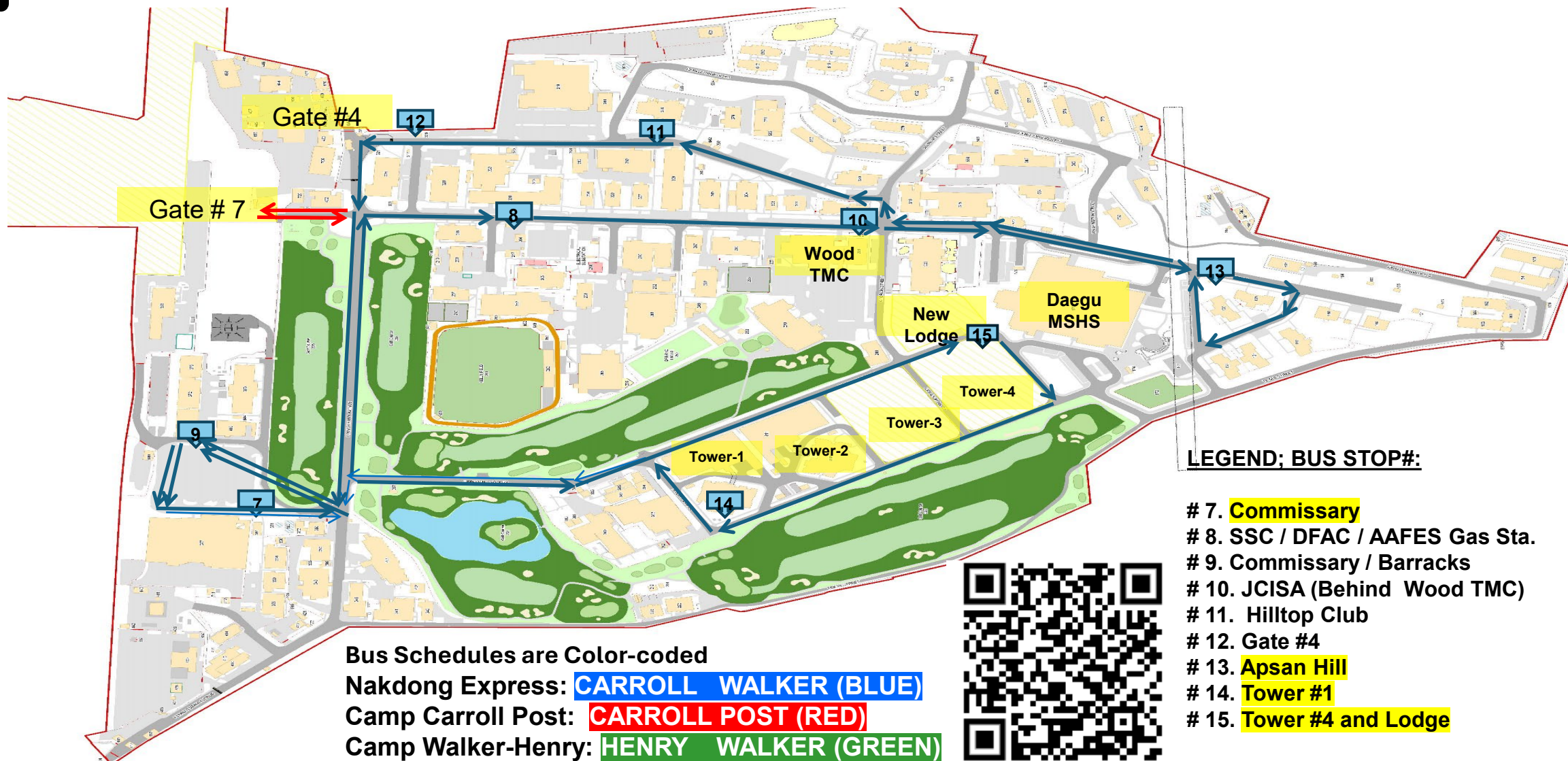

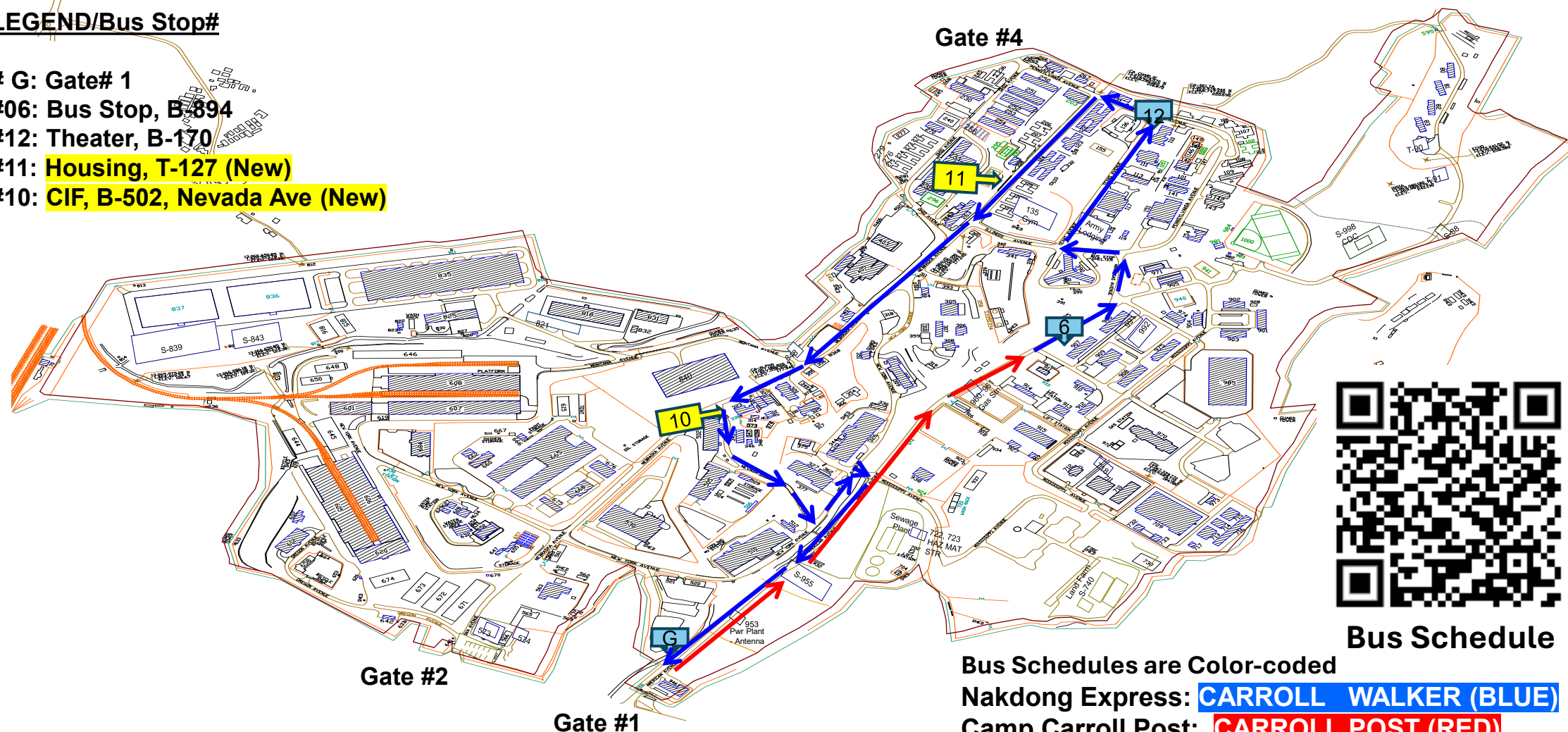


Nakdong Express Cp Carroll Route Changes

WHAT is ASACS?

ASACS stands for **Adolescent Support and Counseling Services**. We are a value added school and community based therapy program providing clinical counseling and mental health services ON SITE in DoDEA schools. We provide not only educational prevention, but also clinical based services that are HIPPA confidential for students in grades 6 -12. Enrollment for clinical services required for clinical mental health counseling.



Counseling Services

ASACS clinicians help students and families gain personal insights, develop strategies, come up with real-life solutions to problems and challenges they face in **every** area of life. Comprehensive psycho-social assessments provided for Individual, family, group therapy. Therapy services also provided for alcohol and drug use and address other mental health concerns.



Other ASACS Services

As trained credentialed professionals, ASACS provide students mental health therapy by building safe, positive relationships, suggesting tools and techniques they clinically deem benefit clients. Classroom education also provide improvement in overall teen functioning, whereas, parent workshops increase parent-child cohesion, family unity, and trauma recovery. Group counseling further supports students by addressing specific populations and mental health topics within school settings. ASACS coordinate with youth-focused agencies to collaborate support for teens.

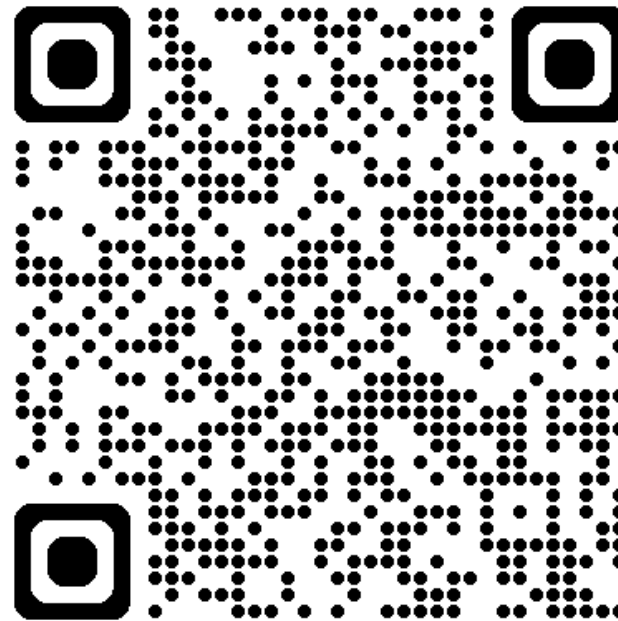

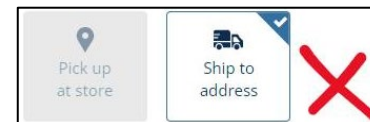

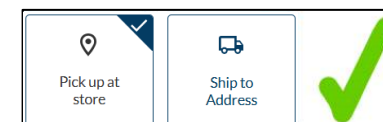


EXCHANGE – Leveraging Korea Exchange's Support

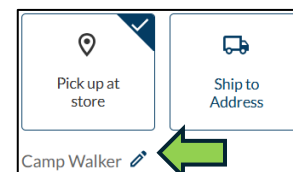
- **BOPIS (Buy On-line Pick-up In Store)**
- **Advantage:** shop on-line and pickup directly at Walker or Carroll PX.
- Great for any items, including large items unable to ship to APO Box.
- Example: sofa, furniture, exercise equipment, large electronics, shoes, clothing, health & beauty, and much much more!
- Be sure your **“My Store”** is set to the location you wish to pickup; **Walker** and **Carroll** are active in Area IV.
- Eligible items on ShopMyExchange.com are easy to spot! (see side illustration)
- **BOPIS TIP:**
- **“7 Available now for pickup”** = means the item is physically present in the store.
- **“30 Ship to store”** = means it will ship from another location and is not physically available there.
- **Shuttle Program**
- Show the item of interest to our Walker/Carroll PX staff, if available at another Exchange, we'll Shuttle it over for you.
