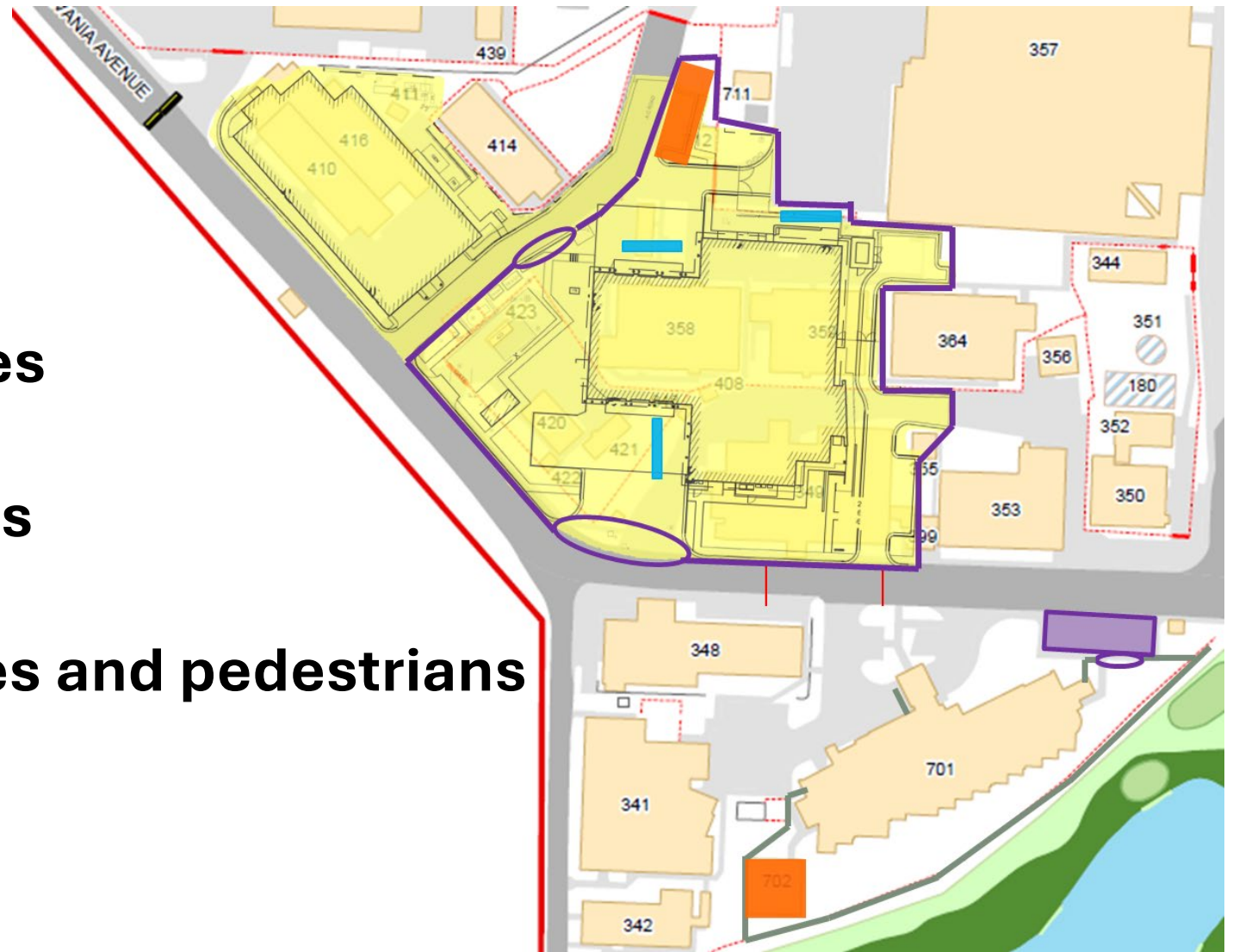

Army Family Housing – PCS Season 2026

Friendly Reminders...

On-Post Housing

- Visit the HSG Office with PCS Orders
- Set-up pre-Termination Inspection & Final Out
- Explain PCS Out & TLA procedures
 - TLA up to 3 days on post
- Inspector conducts Pre-Termination & Final Out Inspection
- Inspector stamp clearing papers & receive TLA Claim Form (USFK Form 122-E)
- Lodging check-out, request to forward receipt to Housing Office. Memo will be sent to SM.

Off-Post Housing

- Following documents must be submitted to Off-post prior to FINAL OUT:
 - Orders
 - 30-Day Termination Notice (signed by landlord)
- Schedule Govt Furniture Pick-Up date
- Schedule & Conduct Final Inspections with Landlord:
 - a. Resolve any issues and damages
 - b. Military Verification of Clearance Form
- Visit the HSG Office to FINAL OUT, Stop OHA, & receive TLA and Claim Form.
 - TLA up to 10 days





HOUSING

Mold season is on the way...Be ready!



- **Humid climate in Korea requires you to pay special attention to mold and mildew that may present itself in your home.**
- **If you see mold starting to grow, clean the affected area with a solution of vinegar and water, do not mix home cleaning products together.**
- **Preventing mold: Keep the home dry; Find and fix water leaks; Discard clutter and excess stored materials; Clean and maintain the home regularly**
- **Extended Absence: Occupant must notify Tower maintenance and the Housing Office when extended absences are anticipated (more than 7 days).**

Transportation

- **Planning is everything to reduce stress during your move**

- Plan Early: Discuss HHG, UB, Leave and Travel Plans
- with your significant other
- Do your Research

- **Household Goods and Unaccompanied Baggage**

- Make arrangements as soon as orders are issued
- Separate your UB from your HHG
- Separate important items/documents (i.e., legal documents, medical records, medication/prescription, school records, passports), so you can carry them with you on the plane
- Downsize - Get rid of things you no longer need

Travel

- Consider your leave travel when planning your PCS
- Service Members must use Patriot Express when available
- Civilians should schedule travel through the Commercial Travel Office

- **Pet transportation:**

- Make plans and reservations early
- Space limited and breed restrictions apply
- Ensure both airlines have your pet reservation for code shares
- Large pets may have to fly in the cargo hold, with seasonal temperature restrictions
 - **Reimbursement (limited)**
 - **\$550 (CONUS) or \$2,000 (OCONUS)**
 - **1 pet per household (Cat or Dog)**
 - **Leave travel may incur additional costs**

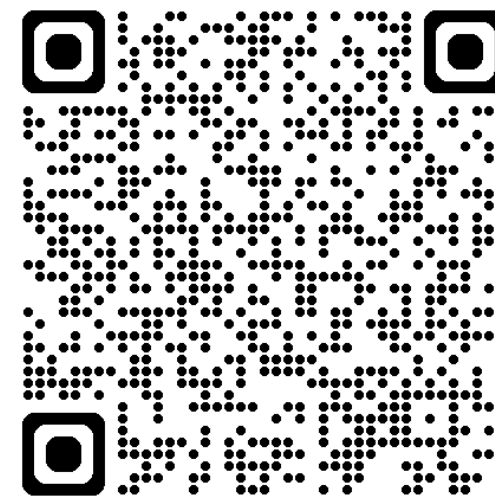

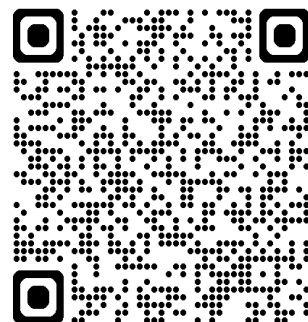

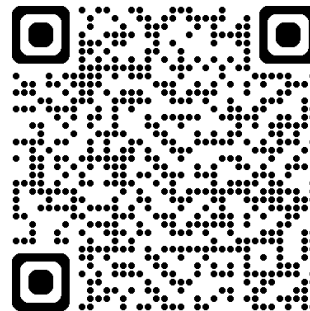

- TCCOR 1 – 12 hours prior to destructive winds

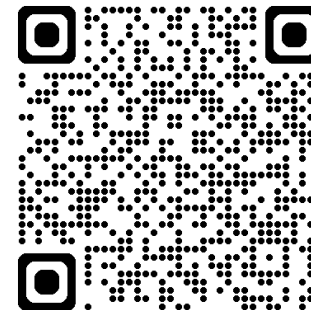
