SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison (USAG) Daegu Policy Letter #21-30, Solid
Waste Management and Recycling

1. References:

2. Applicability: This policy applies to all Soldiers, Civilians, Korean National (KN), contractors, Family Members and partners assigned to, visiting and/or any form of business or recreational activity on USAG Daegu.

3. Purpose: To establish policy for USAG Daegu Recycling program. This policy supports the DoD mandated diversion goal of installation solid waste be diverted, via recycling from disposal at landfills annually.

4. Participation in the USAG Daegu recycling program is mandatory and is enforceable by this Command Policy. It is everyone's responsibility who serves, works, and lives on USAG Daegu to recycle. Commanders/Directors will implement an effective recycling program to minimize waste. This policy letter outlines practices which will be implemented to ensure USAG Daegu achieves DoD mandated solid waste diversion goals.

5. All on-post trash bins, receptacles and dumpsters are reserved for on-post offices, Unaccompanied Personnel Housing, Army Family Housing and official authorized agencies use. Users will make every effort to segregate on-post trash into recyclable and non-recyclable containers as appropriate.

6. It is prohibited to bring off-post trash to on-post for disposal. Personnel (Soldiers, Civilians, Korean National (KN), Contractors, Family Members, etc.) residing off-post will adhere to and utilize host nation trash segregation and recycling program in accordance with their established lease.

7. Violation of this policy may be subject to adverse administrative actions that may include but not be limited to: a written warning letter; notification through the violator's chain of command; suspension of driving privileges; or other actions determined by USAG Daegu Garrison Commander and/or the violator's leadership.
