

# DES – Hi-Pass Usage

- If you want to purchase the OBU you can stop at designated Hi-Pass distribution centers at the toll booth areas. Usually they are to the right after coming through the toll booth. Prior to initial use you must register your OBU with the Toll Booth Office. Once registered you must use the pre-paid card and can add to it at the pay toll booth once you start running out.
- Remember, failure to pay your fines could result in your failure to DEROS out of country for Failure to Pay Just Debt for Service Members and International could be put in place for Non-Service Members until the fine is paid in full. You cannot deregister your vehicle until all fines are paid.



# DES – Hi-Pass Usage

- The DES has received numerous complaints from the Korea Expressway Division about SOFA plated vehicles using the Hi-Pass lanes without having the correct On-Board Unit (OBU) authorizing them to use it.
- Illegal use of the Hi-Pass results in a fine to the user for the original toll times 10. (Example: Toll 10,000 won X 10 (fine)= 110,000 won for total fee). An additional fee is accumulated if you fail to pay in a timely manner.
- If you don't have a designated Hi-Pass OBU, you must use the pay lanes at the toll booths.
