



Solid Waste Program

- Separate the wastes by the category: i.e. paper, plastic, aluminum, glass.
- Empty and rinse out cans, bottles and containers prior to putting them into the recycling containers.
- If no recycling dumpster, bagged items may also be placed in the trash dumpsters to help USAG Daegu’s reportable diversion rate, but the base doesn't earn revenue when recyclables are trashed.

WHAT CAN GO IN MY RECYCLING BIN?



Paper/Cardboard Boxes

(Empty and flatten boxes before placing in recycling bin)

Newspapers, books, notebooks, copying paper, corrugated cardboard boxes, paper bags, paper cup, milk cartons, calendar.



Plastic

(Drain before placing in recycle bin. Separate all metal parts if any and recycle separately)

Drinking plastic bottle, soy sauce and olive oil bottle, yogurt bottle, cleanser container, shampoo bottle, detergent container, toys.



Aluminum Can

(Drain before placing in recycle bin)

Beverage cans, food can, powered milk can, canned food containers, spray cans, iron tools, iron cookware, wire, nails, aluminum, stainless steel, sash, tinfoil.



Butane can, Insecticide can

If contents remain in container donate to Self Help Store. If empty of contents and aerosol, puncture spray cans and place in aluminum recycle bin.



Glass

(Rinsed and free of food or liquid residue) Drinking bottle, alcohol bottle, other kinds of glass bottles.

FOOD WASTE RECYCLING

All food waste should be drained and placed in the FOOD WASTE container

FOOD ONLY, NO PLASTIC BAGS!



Towers Food Waste Containers

Instructions for Food Waste Container

Please drain liquid at sink prior to dumping.

STEP 1. Press "O": Open the Lid

STEP 2. Dump Food waste ONLY.

No Plastics Bags or Containers.

(No plastic bags, bones, egg or hard shells from shell fish (clam), or food mixed with other wastes)

STEP 3. Press "C": Close the Lid

COOKING OIL RECYCLING

Used cooking oil must be poured into the cooking oil container that's been provided to you at the recycling point.



NON-RECYCLABLE FOOD WASTE THAT MUST GO INTO TRASH BINS

Vegetable Stem & Husks	"Root" of chives, scallion, and water parsley, pepper seed, pepper stem, "Husk" of onion, garlic and ginger and corn stem
Fruit Seeds & Pits	Fruit seeds (peach, apricot, avocado and persimmon)
Bones	Cow, pig, chicken and fish
Shells	Clam shells, egg shells, clam and oyster shells, crustacean shells (lobster, crab, shrimp), hard nut shells (walnut, peanut, etc)
Others	Grounded coffee, tea grounds, coffee bags, tea bags



Q. What cannot be recycled?

A. Common Trash Items:

Paper with food, wax paper, used tissue and napkins, styrofoam, pet wastes, personal hygiene items and non-recyclable food waste.
