What
does
MOLD
look
like?



- Bathroom vent not cleaned by the occupant
- Disrupts the proper ventilation of moisture from the room
- Moisture condenses on the tiles providing the water that mold needs to grow
- Moisture escapes from the bathroom, condensation and mold growth on the AC vent



- Humidity control
 - Bathroom/kitchen ventilation
 - Annual or routine cleaning of ventilation system
 - If you see condensation – dry
- Cleanliness
 - Bathroom vents
 - Bathtub/shower free of minerals/soap scum
- If see it, clean it
 - Take photo
 - Use bleach to clean
- If it comes back, report
 - Demand Maintenance Order (DMO) to investigate source of moisture
