- Open the door.

- To continue the programme, close the door.

Open the door and press the (-) "Terminate programme" button.Close the door.

 Open the door when the buzzer has sounded 5 times (programme stop). "Ready" is briefly displayed, the appliance automatically switches off after 5 seconds. Arrange dishwasher-proof utensils (having removed any ash, wax, grease or ink. Coarsely remove sticky labels, large remnants of jam, milk products or food) according to the operating instructions and check that the spray arms can rotate freely.
