- **Hatch Act Training Available for Employees**

Army personnel, Soldiers and civilian employees swear an oath to protect and defend the Constitution of the United States. It is important that all Army personnel are aware of and understand the permissible and impermissible political activities for Soldiers and civilian employees respectively. 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- **Attend Law School At Government Expense Through The Funded Legal Education Program**

The Office of The Judge Advocate General is now accepting applications for the Army's Funded Legal Education Program. Under this program, the Army projects sending up to 25 active duty commissioned officers and new this year-NCOs to civilian law school at government expense. Selected officers and NCOs will attend law school beginning in fall 2021 and will remain on active duty while attending law school.

This program is open to Regular Army Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants First Class, Staff Sergeants, and Sergeants from the Operations Division (OD), Operations Support Division (OSD), Force Sustainment Division (FSD), Health Services Division (HSD), Army Special Operations Force (ARSOFF), and Cyber (CB). Commissioned Officer applicants must have at least two, but not more than six, years of total active Federal service at the time legal training begins. NCO applicants must have at least four, but not more than eight, years of total active Federal service at the time legal training begins. Eligibility is governed by statute (10 U.S.C. 2004) and is non-waivable.

- **Parking Enforcement In The Community**

Visitors, workers, and residents of the Fort Detrick community are cautioned that private property owners located near Fort Detrick have complained that individuals are parking on their private property while they visit/work at Fort Detrick. Such an action may subject those individuals to action by the private property owners, including but not limited to towing of those vehicles.

On a similar note, while residents and evening shift workers are expected to be parking on Fort Detrick overnight, other individuals who want to park their vehicles on Fort Detrick overnight (or through the period of a TDY trip) must get approval in advance from the Fort Detrick Provost Marshal Office. It is possible that the vehicle will need to be parked in a specific location. This is discussed in Fort Detrick Regulation 190-5, Fort Detrick Traffic Code, Appendix at paragraph 10.

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- **August is Antiterrorism Awareness Month**

The purpose of this year's AT Awareness month is to instill army-wide heightened awareness and vigilance to prevent terrorist attacks and protect Army critical resources from acts of terrorism. Due to the current physical distancing requirements, Fort Detrick's AT awareness campaign will be done via social media posts and e-mails. This week will focus on the reporting of suspicious activity.

### ***WHY REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY?***

Law enforcement officials simply can't be everywhere; therefore, everyone plays a role in protecting the installation and community. It's your eyes and ears which can be of enormous help in the prevention of terrorism. You may see or hear things that seem out of the ordinary. Law enforcement relies on the instincts and perceptions of all members of the community to detect out of the ordinary activity. Prompt reporting can help prevent or impede terrorist attacks.

Keys to reporting:

- Who you saw
- What, When, and Where you saw it
- Why it was suspicious

### ***WHAT IS SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY?***

**Surveillance:** Recording or monitoring activities by use of camera/binoculars, note taking, mapping, or drawing diagrams.

**Elicitation:** Attempts to gain information by mail, phone, or in person about military operations or personnel.

**Tests of Security:** Attempts to measure reaction times of security breaches.

**Suspicious Persons Out of Place:** People who don't seem to belong.

**Acquiring Materials:** Stealing uniforms, identification cards/badges, or additional controlled items.
