The purpose of the Fort Detrick Military Retiree Council is to assist the Commander, U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Fort Detrick and the Senior Commander, U.S. Army Medical Research and Development Command (USAMRDC) and Fort Detrick in meeting the objectives of the retirement program outlined in Chapter 4, AR 600-8-7. The retiree council aims at developing a strong communication link between the retired military community and the Active Army.
