

INSTALLATION SAFETY BULLETIN SB 24-07-01

FIREWORKS SAFETY

- Use fireworks outdoors only.
- Obey local laws. If fire-works are not legal where you live, do not use them.
- **Always** have water handy.
- Only use fireworks as intended. Don't try to alter them or combine them.
- SAFETY BULLETIN Never relight a "dud" firework. Wait **<u>20 minutes</u>** and then soak it in a bucket of water.



- Spectators should keep a safe distance from the shooter and the shooter should wear safety glasses.
- **Only persons over the age of 12** should be allowed to handle fireworks – including sparklers - of any type.
- Think about your pet. Animals have sensitive ears and can be extremely frightened or stressed on the Fourth of July. Keep pets indoors to reduce the risk that they'll run loose or get injured.
- **Never** try to make your own fireworks.
