Effective Immediately:

Active-Duty and activated Reserve Component Soldiers on Title 10 Orders who had their Tuition Assistance (TA) requests deleted or were unable to request TA due to the partial government shutdown and attended a TA eligible course, with term start dates from 1-30 October 2025 are eligible to submit a Historical Tuition Assistance Request (HTAR).

Construction Projects Updates:

- **Amber Drive will be closed between the traffic circle and Ditto Avenue on weekends until the end of January 2026. Old Farm Gate is accessible during normal operating hours, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., as an alternative for residents and personnel on Saturdays and Sundays.**
- **The Fitness Track and Infield is closed for renovation and set to reopen June 2026. Traffic change at Forest Glen Building 156 off Stephen Sitter Ave. is scheduled for demolition 02/04/2026 through the end of April.**
- Beginning Feb. 4, a portion of Stephen Sitter Ave near building 156 on Forest Glen Annex will be reduced to one lane. This reduction is necessary to ensure the safety of personnel actively working on the demolition of Building 156. The project is expected to continue through the end of April 2026. Vehicle operators are asked to please pay attention to the flaggers directing traffic during this time.

- **Lane Closures at Nallin Farm Gate** In the beginning phase, both lanes of the inbound side will be closed and redirected to a single lane normally designated as an outbound lane. Once inbound lane barriers are replaced, both outbound lanes will close, and vehicles will be redirected to a single lane normally designated as an inbound lane. These improvements are essential to ensure the long-term safety and reliability of Nallin Farm Gate for the traveling public. This project is estimated to take several months to complete. We understand that lane closures can cause inconvenience, and we apologize for any disruption this may cause. We are committed to delivering a high-quality project that will benefit the Fort Detrick community for years to come.
- **Beasley Dr. between B375 and B393 (including the perimeter walking path) and Davis St. is closed for the duration of an ongoing demolition project in that area. The project is expected to last until 2031.**

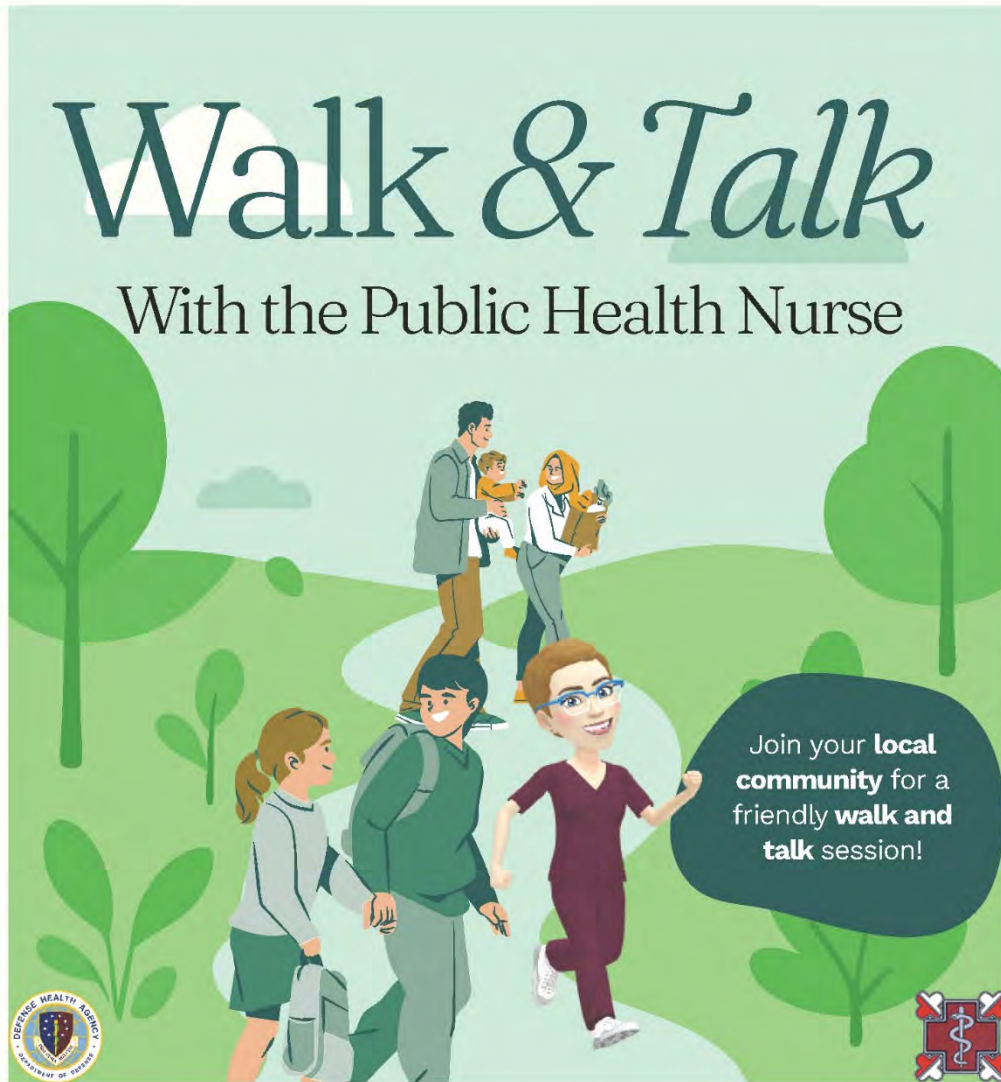

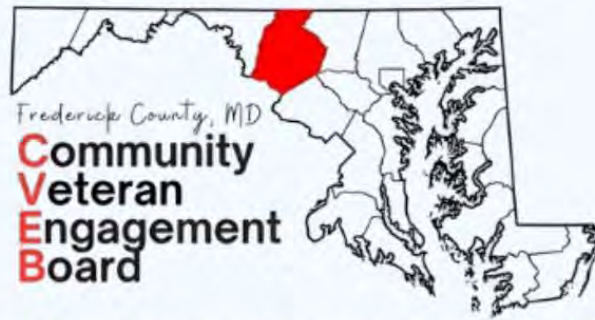
