- **The Directorate of Public Works will be performing a flushing program between 21 July and 25 July.**

Flushing has been found to prevent accumulation of material in the pipes and improve water quality. With the recent decommissioning of AKO, Service Members (SM) are no longer able to access their Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) information or complete SM portions of the Periodic and Deployment Health Assessments, via the MyMedPros link previously available through AKO. New Process: SMs must access their IMR and Self-Service widget via their Home Portal, thru the Medical Readiness Portal. \*Use the amounts in parentheses for continuous work when rest breaks are not possible. Leaders should ensure several hours of rest and rehydration time after continuous work.

This guidance will sustain performance and hydration for at least 4 hours of work in the specified heat category. Fluid needs can vary based on individual differences (± ¼ qt/hr) and exposure to full sun or full shade (± ¼ qt/hr).

Rest means minimal physical activity (sitting or standing) in the shade if possible.

Body Armor - Add 5°F to WBGT index in humid climates.

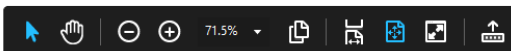
NBC (MOPP 4) - Add 10°F (Easy Work) or 20°F (Moderate or Hard Work) to WBGT Index.

**CAUTION:** Hourly fluid intake should not exceed 1½ qts. Daily fluid intake should not exceed 12 qts.
