• The Fort Detrick Legal Assistance Office (LAO) will shortly be at reduced staffing due to the pending departure of the office's sole Legal Assistance Attorney until a replacement is hired. Consequently, this impacts the Fort Detrick LAO's ability to schedule appointments for clients requiring assistance on the drafting of wills/trusts/separation agreements/responses to adverse administrative actions or those seeking advice on personal legal problems (marital disputes, child custody and support, landlord tenant disputes, consumer affairs matters, debt issues, and immigration matters). However, there will be a small number of appointments available. Clients who need to meet with an attorney for these matters (and other matters described in Army Regulation 27-3) may also seek an appointment with another military LAO, e.g., Fort Belvoir, Fort Meade, Fort Myer, or Aberdeen Proving Ground.

The LAO remains committed to assisting clients with their legal assistance needs.

Notary service and preparation of powers of attorney is not affected. Eligible patrons include active duty military and uniformed service members of the Public Health Service and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (and their military ID card holding dependents), and retired military members collecting retired pay (and their military dependent ID card holding dependents).

Notary service is available between 0830-1100 and 1300-1600 on weekdays except for Friday 22 April and Monday 25 April. Individuals seeking powers of attorney should call in advance to 301-619-2221 to provide details needed so the document can be prepared prior to their arrival.

c. Ensure that TARP training is conducted in a live environment and that online training using the CBT is used only when the conditions in paragraph 2-4i apply.

i. When live training is not possible, such as in deployed theaters of operation, units in remote locations without access to CI support, or when the supporting CI unit does not have the resources to conduct the training, units will complete the CBT that is available on the Army Learning Management System (ALMS) Web site at https://www.lms.army.mil This is the only authorized alternative method for TARP training.

j. Any organization-wide training that is not conducted live in which the conditions in paragraph 2-4i do not apply must be approved by the first O-6, or civilian equivalent, in the chain of command. Prior to pursuing this course of action, the unit will coordinate with the supporting CI office to determine whether a CI agent is available to conduct live training.

Clearance holders are required to self-report changes or incidents that may impact their clearances to safeguard the integrity and trustworthiness of the federal and contractor workforce.

SELF-REPORTING WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

By law, security clearance holders are required to self-report all life events — incidents that could impact your ability to meet security clearance requirements. Self-reporting is mandatory, and it's always better to be honest and forthright. Even if you do not have a clearance, your agency may still require you to report to your security office on certain changes and information about yourself. Please contact your agency's security office with any questions regarding your specific situation.

WHAT TO REPORT

CHANGES IN PERSONAL STATUS	This includes any changes to your marital status, cohabitation status (doesn't include non-romantic roommates), and any name changes.
FOREIGN TRAVEL	Foreign travel is defined as ALL trips and vacations abroad, even day trips to Mexico and Canada. Any work trip that is not official government business needs to be reported. If you're stationed abroad, you must report all personal travel to other countries during that time period.
FOREIGN CONTACT	If it's someone that could have personal information about you, including details about your life, they qualify.
LOSS OR COMPROMISE OF INFORMATION	Inadvertent or accidental loss/compromise of classified or other sensitive information.
FINANCIAL PROBLEMS	Filing for bankruptcy, garnishment of wages, having a lien placed on your property for failing to pay a creditor, eviction from a residence for failure to pay rent, or inability to meet all financial commitments.
ARRESTS	Any arrest, regardless of whether or not charges were filed, or general involvement with the legal system (such as being sued, or you filed a claim against someone else).
PSYCHOLOGICAL OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING	Reportable mental health issues include legal findings of mental incompetence, court-ordered mental health care, in-patient mental health care, certain diagnoses which may impair judgment or reliability, and self- appraised mental health concerns that could impact judgment or reliability. Please note that seeking mental health treatment and counseling in and of itself is NOT a reason to revoke a clearance. Seeking care for personal
	wellness and recovery may contribute favorably to decisions about your eligibility or continuous evaluation.
