Army Housing Resources

- **Suspension of the Residential Communities Initiative (RCI) Energy Conservation Program**

Effective March 1, 2019, the Department of the Army has decided to suspend the Residential Communities Initiative (RCI) Energy Conservation Program until further notice. As residents are aware, this program was implemented by the Army to promote energy conservation in privatized housing by providing incentives to residents for decreased utility consumption.

As of March 1, residents will no longer be billed for above average utility consumption. Please note, residents who had set-up automatic payments for utility billing should cancel those services going forward.

Your monthly utility use will continue to be tracked and you will continue to receive a monthly consumption report or 'mock bill' for informational purposes only—no action will be required on your part.

The Army will be using this time to perform a comprehensive review of the program and all associated data collection and billing methodology. We greatly appreciate your

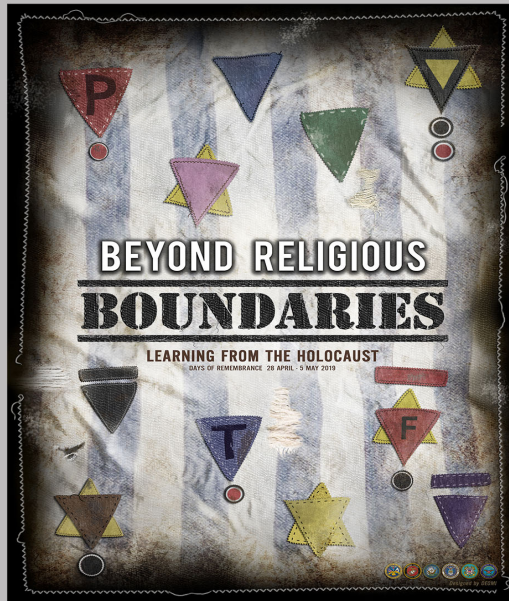

- **Child Safety Seat Checkpoint at Lowe's April 5 from 12-3 p.m.**
Over 83 percent of Maryland child safety seats are installed or used incorrectly. On Friday, April 5, 2019, the Frederick County Division of Fire and Rescue Services will be hosting a child safety seat checkpoint at both Frederick Lowe's locations, 5611 Buckeystown Pike, and Clemson Corner 7850 Wormans Mill Rd. in Frederick from 12-3 p.m.

Maryland's current Law requires that children under eight years old to ride in an appropriate child restraint, unless the child is 4'9" or taller. Children from ages 8 to 16 years old not secured in a child restraint must be secured in the vehicle's seat belt, in every seating position in the vehicle. It's recommended that children ride in the back seat until the age of 13.

There will be child safety seat technicians on hand to show parents of young children how to properly install their child's car seat. Certified child passenger safety technicians
