## EXPIRING COMMON ACCESS CARDS:

\* Civilian and Military CAC's expiring within 30 days temporarily be renewed using the RAPIDS Self-Service Portal at https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/self\_service. This will extend your current certificates to 31 AUG 2020.

\* Contractor CAC's must request their period of eligibility to be extended in the Trusted associate Sponsorship System (TASS), Contact your COR or TA to request this extension
