What Qualifies as a Worthy Job Training, Employment, Skills, Training, Apprenticeships & Internships for Soldiers?

- ✓ GI Bill eligible or no cost to Service Member
- ✓ Guaranteed Job/Interview into an open position
- ✓ Builds upon skills acquired during military service
- ✓ Provides skills that relate to civilian occupation with industry recognized credentials
- ✓ A high probability of employment
- ✓ Pay commensurate with the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to perform the job
