Eligibility: Purple Heart recipient, Spouse and Children –21 January deadline.

Rotary Purple Heart Scholarship

Eligibility: Members assigned to the 10th Mountain Division who have been awarded the Purple Heart while the division was stationed at Fort Drum, or their dependents – 1 April deadline on most applications. www.nnycf.org

Eligibility: Any 1st Brigade affiliate through the non-profit organization dedicated to serving 1st Brigade at Fort Drum.

For veterans and military personnel interested in attending a participating career college. Open to active duty, reservists and honorably discharged and retired veterans. Must have access to tuition assistance and government-supported financial aid through the GI Bill and other programs.
