Stormwater outreach material focused on industrial stormwater, illicit discharges household stormwater management. 2,679 Fort Drum soldiers received stormwater training.

A. Briefly summarize the Measurable Goal identified in the SWMPP in this reporting period.

All outfalls on Fort Drum have been mapped and will continue to be updated as necessary. 52 outfalls were inspected once per quarter for illicit discharges and any other stormwater violations. Water samples were taken from 43 outfalls to test for pollutants of concern. Buildings across the installation that may contribute POCs to the watershed were inspected monthly for illicit discharges. Fort Drum residents were given outreach materials on how to prevent illicit discharges and spills.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

Dry weather inspections and monthly pollutant of concern inspections indicated no evidence of indirect illicit discharges. Water samples identified one location which exceeded benchmark levels. This location was found to have naturally occuring magnesium rock formations. Fort Drum found illegal dumpings of used arms and tires that has been addressed and properly cleaned. Two sanitary sewer incidences were identified and properly taken care of by replacing damaged pipelines.
