Specific programs include: Screening for TBI, Depression, PTSD, Anxiety, ADHD and other behavioral health conditions; Individual and Group Counseling: Medication Management; and evaluation and treatment for partner relational problems and domestic violence. A Behavioral Health Triage Clinic is available during regular duty hours for Soldiers with urgent behavioral health issues at each DBH clinic. Referrals to inpatient care at other facilities are available as determined by the treatment team. Consultation and training is available for command teams and units to address organizational challenges. resilience, and behavioral health promotion.
