

Suicide Prevention Program (SP2)



Unit Training

IAW DA PAM 600-24 and OPORD 12-27

all completed unit trainings must be reported to the SPPM and entered into DTMS within <u>30 days</u> of completion

- Ask, Care and Escort (ACE) 90 min. Required annual suicide prevention training for all Soldiers.
- ACE-Suicide Intervention (ACE-SI v2.2) T2 1 day. An enhanced version of ACE targeting Leaders in positions of trust.
- ACE-Suicide Intervention (ACE-SI v2.2) T4T 3 days. Instruction on how to facilitate the ACE-SI v.2.2. Candidates must be Staff Sergeant or above, nominated by the Commander and be a proficient facilitator.
- Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) Gatekeeper 2 days. Trains attendees to intervene with a person at risk of suicide. Must be mature, able to handle the class content and the responsibility of intervening. 1 trained Gatekeeper per Platoon
