GENERAL ORDER 1A

TITLE. Off Limits Locations for Personnel within the Authority of the Commander, 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry) and Fort Drum

AUTHORITY. Army Regulation 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations, 27 July 2006.

APPLICABILITY. This General Order applies to individuals subject to military orders and stationed, assigned, and/or attached to the 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry) or the Fort Drum installation.

- 1. STATEMENT OF MILITARY PURPOSE AND NECESSITY. The purpose of this General Order is to outline off limits locations for all active duty military personnel subject to the Senior Commander's authority.
- STANDARDS OF CONDUCT. Personnel are prohibited from purchasing goods or services, parking, entering, and/or accompanying any person to/from the below-listed locations.
 - a. The High Life Novelty Shop, 22220 US Route 11, Watertown, NY 13601
 - b. Trip on the Wild Side, 671 Mill Street, Watertown, NY 13601
 - c. Zonen Limited, 6717 Old Collamer Road, East Syracuse, NY 13057
- d. Eclipse Fusion a/k/a Eclipse Lounge and Bar a/k/a Eclipse Hookah Lounge, 312 Arsenal Street #600, Watertown, NY 13601
- e. The private property belonging to Mr. Travis Jordal in or near Felts Mills, NY, located to the south of Cranesville Block Co., Inc., 23903 Cemetery Road, Felts Mills, NY
- f. All water areas within and adjacent to Fort Drum are off-limits for swimming, except Remington Park and approved public swimming areas.
- g. Black River that borders Fort Drum, except for fishing from the banks, and the portion of the Deer River along County Route 55 from the hamlet of Deer River on Route 26 to Copenhagen, referred to as "Kings Falls/High Gorge."

- 3. INDIVIDUAL DUTY. Persons subject to this General Order have the individual duty to know and understand the prohibitions contained herein.
- 4. PUNITIVE ORDER. The provisions of paragraph 2 are punitive. Soldiers who violate this policy may be subject to adverse administrative action and/or disciplinary action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.
- 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
