

E-Bike Quick Reference Information

Do

- Wear a Helmet
- Use roadway shoulders or bike lanes.
- Obey vehicular flow and traffic signs/signals
- Yield to pedestrians
- Ride in single file
- Use lights and reflective gear during low visibility and at night
- Verify your e-bike classification and it's requirements prior to use

Don't

- Don't ride without PPE
- Don't exceed speed limits
- Don't ride on sidewalks
- Don't use illegal or unregistered motorized devices
- Don't operate distracted, impaired, or while using a cell phone
- Don't ignore traffic signs or signals
- Don't ride recklessly
- Don't allow underage riders or overload the bike
- Don't assume all electric vehicles/e-bikes are legal
