Hazard: The recalled gates violate the mandatory standard for expansion gates and expandable enclosures because a child's torso can fit through the opening between the gate and the floor, posing a risk of serious injury or death due to entrapment.

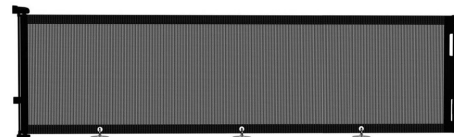

Description: This recall involves retractable safety mesh gates with model number LT-BG01-3. They were sold in white, gray and black. The gates measure about 34 inches high with a retractable width of up to 140 inches and have an iron frame. "Retractable Safety Gate" and the model number are printed on a white label on the side post of the gate. LIVACTI appears on the product packaging.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the recalled gates immediately and contact Qeyan and Yanyanny for instructions on how to receive a full refund. Consumers must destroy the gate by cutting through the mesh and take a photo showing the destroyed gate. Submit the photo to support@livactihome.com.

Apollo Recalls Electric Scooters Due to Fall and Injury Hazards (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: Apollo City Model Year 2024 Electric Scooters

Hazard: The weld line on the electric scooter can crack, causing the stem to break and posing fall and injury hazards.

Description: This recall involves certain serial numbers of Apollo City 2024 model year electric scooters. The dual-motor scooters have top speeds of 32 miles per hour. The scooters have a gray exterior with a headlight and rear brake light. “Apollo” is printed on the stem of the scooter and “Apollo City” is displayed on the rear left side of the grip tape on the deck of the scooter. The affected serial numbers range from 4202240300001 to 4202240301236 and 4202240400001 to 4202240400764. The serial number is located on the bottom of the scooter deck. Consumers can also find their serial number using the Apollo App.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled scooters and contact Apollo for a free replacement stem. To participate in the recall, please go to <https://apolloscooters.co/pages/apollo-city/recall> and fill out the online form. Apollo is recommending that all consumers take their scooters to a service repair location so they can replace the stem on the recalled scooter free of charge. Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received 10 reports of the weld cracking on the stem of the scooter, including four riders who reported coming off the scooter; one reported injury including abrasions.

Name of Product: FENNGQS F7 Pro E-bikes

Hazard: The e-bikes' lithium-ion battery can overheat and ignite, posing serious fire and burn hazards to consumers.

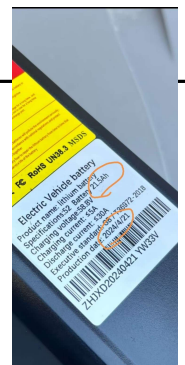

Description: This recall involves FENNGQS F7 Pro electric bikes with batteries manufactured on April 21, 2024. The e-bikes were sold in blue. "FENNGQS" is printed on the downtube and the model number "F7 Pro" is printed on the chain stay, near the rear wheel. The battery's capacity (21.5Ah) and the production date (2024/4/21) are printed on a label on the front of the battery.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the recalled e-bikes immediately and contact FENNGQS for a full refund. Consumers will be asked to write their name, the word "recalled," and the current date next to the battery's production date with a permanent marker. Consumers must then submit a photo clearly showing this information and confirm disposal of the battery in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Consumers should submit the photo to recall@fengqs.work.

Incidents/Injuries: FENNGQS has received 13 reports of e-bikes igniting, two resulting in fires with property damage totaling \$4,000.

Aiho Dressers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Tip-Over and Entrapment (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 24 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-400

Name of Product: Aiho Dressers

Hazard: The recalled dressers are unstable if they are not anchored to the wall, posing serious tip-over and entrapment hazards that can result in injuries or death to children. The dressers fail to meet the mandatory standard, as required by the STURDY Act.

Description: This recall involves the iStore Magnetic Wireless Power Bank, 5000 mAh portable charger. Only model number IST-09991/W05 power banks are included in the recall. The iStore logo is engraved on the front side of the power bank, and the model number is printed on the back, as shown in the photos above. Some units may also have the word “iStore” printed above the model number. The power banks are compatible with various mobile devices, and measure 3 inches by 2 inches by 0.25 inches and weigh around 3.2 ounces. The product was sold with a USB-C to USB-C cable that measures about 12 inches long.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled wireless portable power bank and go to the firm’s website to participate in the recall. Consumers will be asked to submit two photographs via email to recall@istore.co. The first photograph should be the front of the power bank with the word “Recalled” and the date written on it with permanent marker. The second photograph should include the model number, which is located on the back of the power bank. A purchase receipt will be requested but will not be required to participate in the recall. Consumers should immediately dispose of the power banks in accordance with local and state hazardous waste disposal regulations.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received three reports of the wireless power banks overheating and exploding while they were charging, including one incident that resulted in a minor burn to the victim’s arm. The firm received reports of property damage of about \$15,000.

If a child swallows a button cell or coin battery, it can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns or death.

Hazard: The recalled LED gloves violate the mandatory standard for toys containing coin batteries because the compartment that holds the batteries can be easily accessed and opened by children. Additionally, the spare coin batteries provided with the toys are not in child-resistant packaging and do not have the warnings required under Reese's Law. When button cell or coin batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns and death.

Hazard: The magnets on the inside cover can detach, posing an ingestion hazard to children. When high-powered magnets are swallowed, the ingested magnets can attract each other, or other metal objects, and become lodged in the digestive system. This can result in perforations, twisting and/or blockage of the intestines, infection, blood poisoning and death.

Hazard: The minifridges' internal electrical components can short circuit and ignite the surrounding plastic housing, posing fire and burn hazards.

Incidents/Injuries: Curtis International has received at least 26 reports of the minifridges smoking, sparking, burning, melting, overheating and catching fire, with property damages totaling more than \$700,000. Two consumers reported smoke inhalation injuries.

Winston Products Recalls 58-Inch HydroTech Expandable Burst-Proof Hoses Due to Risk of Impact Hazard and Temporarily Impairing Hearing (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: HydroTech 5/8-inch Expandable Burst-Proof Hoses

Hazard: The recalled hoses can burst, posing an impact hazard and a risk of temporarily impaired hearing.

Description: This recall involves HydroTech 5/8-inch Expandable Burst-Proof Hoses manufactured on or before August 31, 2024. The hoses were sold in lengths of 25, 50, 60, 75, 100 and 200 feet in various colors. Date code markings are located on the end of the hose that attaches to the spigot, visible when the black rubber washer is removed. Hoses with no markings or a marking ending in -211, -212, -213, -214, -221, -222, -223, -224, -231, -232, -233, -234, -241, -242 or -243 are included in this recall. On some hose packages, the manufacture date is listed in the month-year format. For example, 0824 is August 2024 and is included in this recall.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled hoses. Consumers that purchased products from Ace Hardware, Do It Best, Home Depot or Walmart should bring their hoses to those stores to return them for a full refund. Consumers who purchased products from other retailers should cut off the regulator-end of their hose and contact Winston Products for a full refund. To receive the refund, consumers should submit photos of the cut hose, showing the date code location with the consumer's initials and the date written in permanent marker on the regulator, to Winston Product's online form at <https://hydrotechproducts.com/recall>.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received at least 222 reports of the hoses bursting, resulting in at least 29 injuries, including one bone bruise, two sprains and five reports of temporarily impaired hearing from the sound of the hose bursting..
