Persilux Brand Zebra Blinds Recalled Due to Strangulation and Entanglement Hazards and Risk of Serious Injury or Death (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 25 September 2025

Recall Number: 25-479

Name of Product: Persilux Zebra Blinds

Hazard: The recalled blinds have long operating cords that can cause death or serious injury to children, due to strangulation and entanglement hazards. The blinds violate the federal rule for window coverings and present a substantial product hazard. In addition, the blinds also violate labeling requirements for window coverings.

Description: This recall involves Persilux-branded zebra blinds. The recalled stock blinds were sold in beige, black, dark gray, light gray and white, with sizes ranging from 22 to 73 inches wide and 64 to 72 inches high. "Persilux and "Zebra Blinds" is printed on the product packaging. "X003FFPT63" is printed on the barcode label.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled blinds and contact Persilux for a free repair kit, including shipping. The repair kit consists of a replacement operating cord wand and installation instructions. Consumers should remove the blind, cut and remove the operating cord and send a photograph of the blinds, with the operating cord removed, to recall@persiluxhome.com.

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Autoez Brand Bamboo Shades Recalled Due to Strangulation and Entanglement Hazards and Risk of Serious Injury or Death (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 25 September 2025

Name of Product: Autoez Bamboo Shades

Hazard: The recalled shades have long operating cords and accessible inner cords that can cause death or serious injury to children, due to strangulation and entanglement hazards. The shades violate the federal rule for window coverings and present a substantial product hazard. In addition, the shades also violate labeling requirements for window coverings.

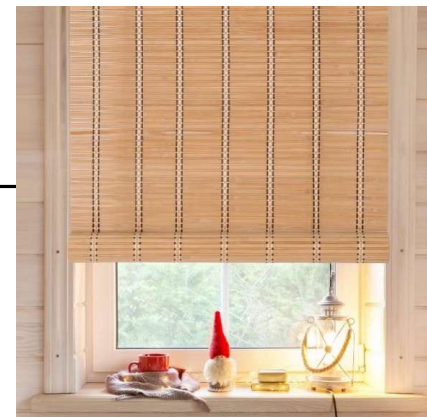

Description: This recall involves Autoez-branded bamboo shades. The recalled bamboo shades were sold in brown, with sizes ranging from 24 to 72 inches wide and 64 to 72 inches high. "Autoez" is printed on the sticker label on the top rail of the shades.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled shades and contact Autoez for a full refund. Consumers should remove the shades, cut the operating cord, write the word "Recalled" on the shades and dispose of the product in the garbage. Consumers should send a photograph of the destroyed window shades in the garbage to Autoez_recall@163.com.

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Mad Rabbit Recalls “RELIEVE Lidocaine Numbing Cream Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Poisoning to Young Children (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: “RELIEVE” Numbing Cream

Hazard: The numbing cream contains lidocaine, which must be in a child-resistant packaging, as required by the Poison Prevention Packaging Act. The numbing cream’s packaging is not child-resistant, posing a risk of serious injury or death from poisoning, if the contents are swallowed by young children.

Description: This recall involves “RELIEVE” numbing cream. The cream comes in a short wide-mouthed white container. A label is located on the front with black lettering and “RELIEVE” in large type and the company’s logo and “Mad Rabbit”, “Numbing Cream” and “Menthol” in smaller type.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately secure the recalled numbing cream out of the sight and reach of children and contact Mad Rabbit via email or online for a free child-resistant lid to store the products. Once the product is secured, consumers can use the product, as directed.

AMTRADING Recalls Hoovy Cooling Gel Insert Pads for Car Seats and Strollers Due to Burn Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 25 September 2025

Recall Number: 25-476

Name of Product: Hoovy Cooling Gel Insert Pads for Car Seats and Strollers

Hazard: The cooling gel pads can become hot if left in the sun or a hot car, posing a burn hazard to young children.

Description: This recall involves black Cooling Gel Insert Pads for strollers or car seats and contain an inner cooling layer that is activated by a child’s weight. The Hoovy logo appears in white on the bottom right corner of the product. The recalled cooling pads are approximately 16.5 inches long by 14.25 inches wide.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled Cooling Gel Insert Pad and contact AMTRADING for instructions on receiving a full refund. Consumers can go to <https://hoovyproducts.com/pages/product-recall> for instructions on how to register for the recall and to dispose of the recalled pad.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received one consumer report where the child experienced second degree burns to his back, requiring medical attention.

Sunbeam Products Recalls More than One Million Oster French Door Countertop Ovens Due to Burn Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 25 September 2025

Recall Number: 25-475

Name of Product: Oster French Door Countertop Ovens

Hazard: The oven's doors can unexpectedly close, posing a burn hazard to consumers.

Description: This recall involves Oster French Door Countertop Ovens with model numbers TSSTTVFDXL, TSSTTVFDDG, TSSTTVFDMAF and TSSTTVFDDAF. The recalled ovens have a spring-loaded bilateral door made of glass with metal handles. A label on the backside of the oven identifies the model number. In addition, the original packaging has information identifying the model number. The four models differ in cooking options (e.g., air fryer) and control types (analog dials or digital push-button controls). "Oster" is engraved on the front bottom right of the oven.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled countertop ovens and contact Sunbeam Products Inc. to receive a free repair kit. The repair kit will include a clip-on device that provides additional holding force to help keep the doors in the open position when reaching in the oven, along with repair instructions and a QR code link to an installation video. The repair kit does not require any tool to install.

Incidents/Injuries: Sunbeam Products Inc. has received 95 reports of the doors unexpectedly closing, resulting in burn injuries to consumers, including two reports of second-degree burns.
