"PLASTIC STOOL" and "Model: YD-1958" are printed on a tracking label located on the back of the bath seat.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bath seats and contact Trankerloop for a full refund. Consumers will be asked to write "Recalled" on the front of the bath seat in permanent marker, disassemble the bath seat by removing the back rest and arm restraints, cut the four suction cups on the bottom and email a photo of the disassembled recalled bath seat showing the marked front of the seat to hkkl147@outlook.com.

Hazard: Moisture trapped inside the bath foam set container can cause pressure to build up, allowing pieces to be forcefully ejected when opened, posing an impact hazard.

The clear flasks contain purple, orange, dark green, pink, blue and light green bath bombs in powder form. "Tubby Tots Fizzy Flask Bath Magic" is printed on the front of each color box. The six potions are individually packaged within a single larger box with plastic wrap. The recalled batch number 082025 is printed on the back of the larger box.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled plastic flask bath foam sets and contact Surreal Brands for a full refund. TheKiddoSpace Recalls Children's Flashcard Talking Toys Due to Risk of Injury from Lead and Phthalate Exposure (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 26 February 2026

Recall Number: 26-296

Name of Product: KiddoSpace Children's Flashcard Talking Toys

Hazard: The recalled children's flashcard toy sets contain levels of lead that exceed the federal lead content ban and levels of phthalates that exceed the federal phthalates ban. Lead and phthalates are toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health issues. In addition, the flashcards also violate the mandatory standard for toys because they fail to comply with the short circuit protection requirement for battery-operated toys.

Hazard: The recalled swing's flexible fabric form loops that can entangle a child's head or neck, posing a risk of serious injury or death from strangulation.

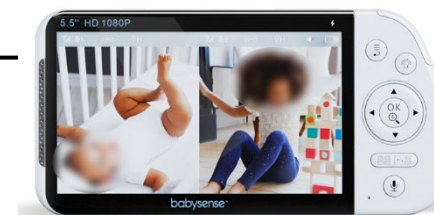

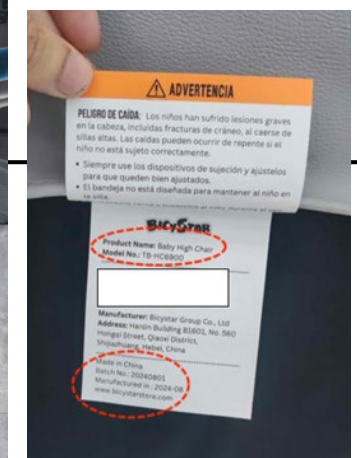

When button cell and coin batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns and death.

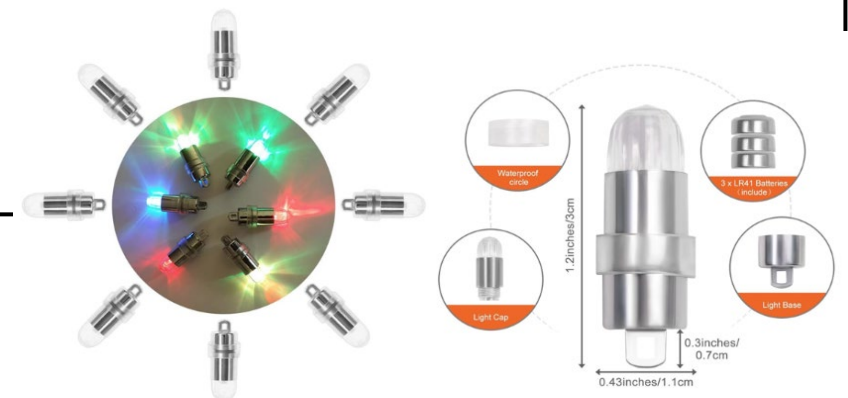

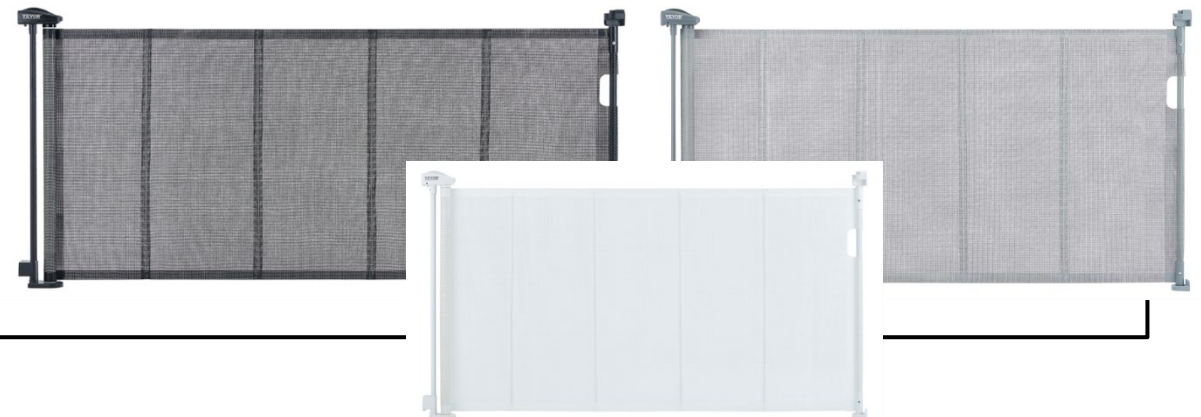

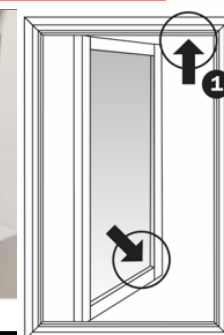
