McLee Creations Recalls MyOnlyStyler Root Booster Hair Dryers Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Electrocution and Shock Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 26 November 2025

Recall Number: 26-125

Name of Product: MyOnlyStyler Root Booster Hair Dryers

Hazard: The handheld hair dryers lack an immersion protection device, which presents a substantial product hazard to consumers, posing the risk of death or serious injury from electrocution or shock if the hair dryers fall into water while plugged in.

Description: This recall involves MyOnlyStyler Root Booster Hair Dryers. The hair dryer was sold in white with black bristles and has “MY ONLY STYLER” printed on the handle. Model number “MOS-22” is printed on the back of the handle. The hair dryer measures 12 inches long by 1.75 inches wide.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately unplug and stop using the recalled hair dryers and contact McLee Creations to receive a full refund. Outdoor Master Children's and Youth Helmets Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Head Injury (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 26 November 2025

Recall Number: 26-122

Name of Product: Outdoor Master Children's and Youth Helmets

Hazard: The recalled children's and youth helmets violate the mandatory safety standard for bicycle helmets. Particularly, the helmets do not comply with the positional stability and coverage requirements. The helmets can fail to protect the user in the event of a crash, posing a risk of injury or death due to head injury.

Description: This recall involves two models of Outdoor Master-branded children's and youth bicycle/multi-purpose helmets. Helmet model OM-TD BIKE is blue with a dinosaur print, has black padding, black straps, a black buckle and a black plastic knob at the back of the helmet for adjusting the fitting; and was sold in children's size small (S), fitting a head circumference from 48 to 52 cm (18.9 to 20.5 inches). "OM-TD BIKE" and "05/2024" (the manufacture date) is printed on a label inside the helmet, and the brand is printed on the back of the helmet. Helmet model OM-KSKB is deep green with black padding, yellow straps, a black buckle and a black plastic knob at the back of the helmet for adjusting the fitting; and was sold in youth size small (S), fitting a head circumference from 46 to 52 cm (18.1 to 20.5 inches). "OM-KSKB" and "11/2022" (the manufacture date) is printed on a label inside the helmet and the brand is printed on the front and back of the helmet.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled helmets and contact Outdoor Master for instructions on how to register for a full refund.

Convertible Highchairs Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Fall and Entrapment Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 26 November 2025

Name of Product: Baby Highchairs (convertible)

Hazard: The highchairs violate the mandatory standard for highchairs because they were sold without the required attached restraint system, posing a deadly fall hazard to babies. In addition, a child's head can become trapped in the opening between the seat and tray, posing a deadly entrapment hazard.

Description: This recall involves baby highchairs sold in beige or pink with a matching removable seat cushion, detachable tray, and footrest. The highchairs convert into an infant swing and are reclinable and collapsible. "Product No.: HA-028" is printed on a tracking label on the seatback.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled highchairs and contact Rotinyard for a full refund. Consumers should disassemble the highchairs, cut the restraints and fabric seat cushion insert, and email photos of the destroyed restraints and cushion to trailblazeramz@outlook.com. Name of Product: Ozark Trail Tabletop 1-Burner Butane Camping Stoves

Hazard: The stoves can explode or catch fire, posing a burn and fire hazard to consumers.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled stoves and return the product to any Walmart retail store for a full refund.

In addition, the baby loungers do not have a stand, posing a fall hazard if used on elevated surfaces. These violations create an unsafe sleeping environment and can cause death or serious injury.

Vivohome Adult Portable Bed Rails Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment and Asphyxiation Hazards (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: Vivohome Adult Portable Bed Rails

Hazard: The recalled bed rails violate standard for adult portable bed rails, posing a serious entrapment hazard and risk of death by asphyxiation. When the bed rails are attached to a bed, users can become entrapped within the bed rail or between the bed rail and the side of the mattress. In addition, the bed rails do not bear the required hazard warning labels.

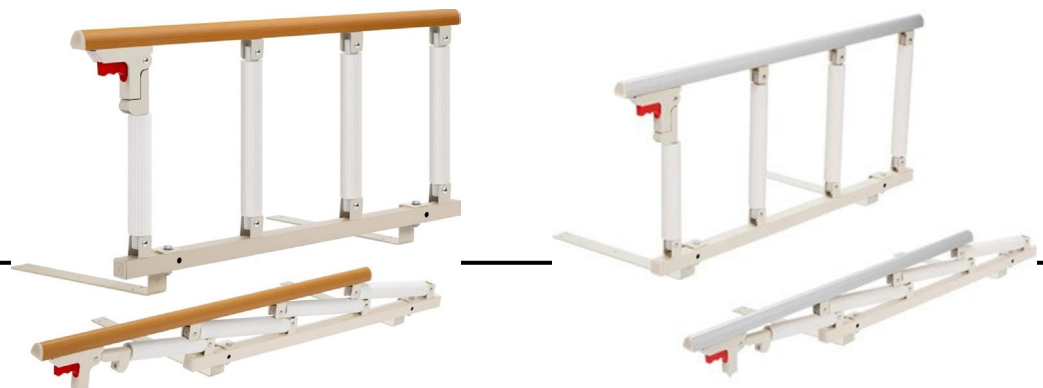

Description: This recall involves Vivohome-branded adult portable bed rails sold for use on adult beds. The recalled bed rails measure about 36.6 inches long, 16.1 inches wide and 15.7 inches in height and have four metallic stand bars with padding, a wooden (model VH1316-WC) or metallic (model VH1316-WH) top bar with a red release button that collapses the bed rail. The model number is printed on the product packaging and the product registration card.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bed rails and contact Vivohome for a full refund. Consumers will be asked to write "RECALLED" on the rails with permanent marker and send a photo of the marked bed rails to support@3qmart.com. Ikuso Safety Gates Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death to Children from Entrapment (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: Ikuso Safety Gates

Hazard: The recalled gates violate the mandatory standard for expansion gates and expandable enclosures because a child's torso can fit through the opening between the gate slat and the side wall, posing a risk of serious injury or death due to entrapment.

Description: This recall involves Ikuso-branded safety pressure-mounted safety gates. The white steel safety gates were sold in two adjustable size ranges: between 30 inches and 48 inches (model Door-Gen1-123) and between 30 inches and 63 inches (model Door-Gen1-159). "Ikuso" is printed on the latch on the top of the gates, and the model numbers are on labels located on the side-post under the latch of the gate.

Hazard: The recalled bed rails violate the mandatory standard for adult portable bed rails because when the bed rails are attached to a bed, users can become entrapped within the bed rail or between the bed rail and the side of the mattress, posing a serious entrapment hazard and risk of death by asphyxiation. In addition, the bed rails do not bear the required hazard warning labels.

Some models have support legs and motion-sensor lights. The recalled bed rails have “KingPavonini” written on the fabric cover.

Hazard: The recalled dressers are unstable if they are not anchored to the wall, posing tip-over and entrapment hazards that can result in serious injuries or death to children. The dressers violate the mandatory standard as required by the STURDY Act.
