Children's Toys Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Choking (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Recall Number: 25-433

Name of Product: Children's Spiral Tower Toys

Hazard: The recalled toy contains small balls and is intended for children under three years of age, which violates the small ball ban, posing a deadly choking hazard.

Description: This recall involves three-tiered spiral children's tower toys. The recalled toy has three levels and a basketball hoop with a character's face at the top. The toy measures about 10 inches high by 4 inches wide and came with three yellow balls.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately take the toy away from children and contact **STWUQIKONG** for a full refund. Consumers will be asked to throw the product away and send a photo of the disposed product to STWUQIKONG_RECALL@hotmail.com.

ESR HaloLock Wireless Power Banks Recalled Due to Fire and Burn Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Recall Number: 25-437

Name of Product: ESR HaloLock Wireless Power Banks

Hazard: The lithium-ion battery in the recalled power banks can overheat and ignite, posing fire and burn hazards to consumers.

Description: This recall involves ESR HaloLock wireless power banks with model numbers 2G520, 2G505B and 2G512B. “ESR” is printed on the back and the model number is printed on the right side of the pocket-size power banks. They were sold in dark blue, light blue, gray, white and black. All recalled models have five circular LED display lights on one side.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled power banks and contact Waymeet for a full refund. Consumers will be asked to send to support@esrtech.com their order number (not required) and a photo of the recalled power bank showing the model number with the word “Recalled” written on it in permanent marker. Consumers should dispose of the power banks in accordance with local and state hazardous waste disposal regulations.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received nine reports of the lithium-ion battery catching fire and exploding, resulting in property damage of about \$20,000. No injuries have been reported.

Drinkmate Recalls 1-Liter Carbonation Bottles Due to Serious Impact and Laceration Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Name of Product: Drinkmate 1L Carbonation Bottles

Hazard: The recalled Drinkmate 1L Carbonation Bottles can explode during use, posing serious impact, laceration and hearing damage hazards to users and bystanders.

Description: This recall involves certain 1L Carbonation Bottles with a clear polyethylene terephthalate (PET) body and caps and bases in red, blue, white and black plastic. The recalled bottles have expiration dates between 01/2026 and 10/2026, which are printed on the side of the bottle. Only bottles within these expiration dates are included in the recall. These bottles were sold both individually and as part of some Drinkmate OmniFizz starter kits.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bottles and contact Drinkmate to receive a free replacement bottle. Consumers will be asked to fill out a replacement form at <https://idrinkproducts.com/pages/drinkmate-safety-recall-of-1l-pet-bottles>, upload a photo of the bottle permanently marked with the word “Recall” and properly dispose of it. Consumers will receive a code to order the free replacement bottle through Drinkmate’s website, shipping included.

Incidents/Injuries: Drinkmate has received eight reports of the bottle exploding while in use, including four reports resulting in lacerations, impact injuries and hearing damage.

Synergy Housewares Recalls Wolfgang Puck Petite Tea Kettles Due to Burn Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Recall Number: 25-432

Name of Product: Wolfgang Puck Stainless Steel Petite Tea Kettles

Hazard: The kettle's infuser basket lid is loose and can fall off during use, posing a burn hazard to consumers.

Description: This recall involves Wolfgang Puck-branded petite tea kettles sold with a removable tea infuser basket. The recalled, 14 oz. capacity, stainless-steel kettle was sold in beige, black, pink and red. "Wolfgang Puck Petite Kettle" and a six-digit lot code (022020, 022021, 022022, 042022, 022023 or 032023) appears on the kettle's underside.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the tea kettle immediately and contact Synergy Housewares for a free new lid for the kettle.

Incidents/Injuries: Synergy Housewares has received at least 10 reports of incidents involving the kettle lids, including 5 resulting in injuries such as burns or scalding from the lid falling off the kettle during use.

Firefly Fuel Recalls Firefly Safe & Green 32 oz. Fuel Bottles Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Poisoning to Young Children (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Recall Number: 25-434

Name of Product: Firefly Safe & Green 32 oz. Fuel Bottles

Hazard: The recalled Safe & Green 32 oz. fuel bottles contain hydrocarbons, which must be in child-resistant packaging, as required by the Poison Prevention Packaging Act. The product includes a nozzle applicator which is not child-resistant, violating the mandatory standard. When the applicator is used instead of the child-resistant closure, it poses a deadly poisoning hazard to young children. Hydrocarbons can get into the lungs, causing chemical pneumonia and pulmonary damage, which can be fatal. In addition, the torch fuel violates the Federal Hazardous Substances Act because it is incorrectly labeled as “Non-Toxic”.

Description: This recall involves the Firefly Safe & Green 32 oz. bottles. The fuel comes in a transparent bottle with a white cap and nozzle applicator. The fuel bears the “Firefly” brand, “Safe & Green” in large green font, followed by “The One Fuel.” The label also states “Non-Toxic”, “Readily Biodegradable”, “Odorless”, “Bright Flame” and “Certified Kosher” on the front of the bottle. The rear of the bottle contains hazard labeling and the firm’s business address.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately remove the nozzle applicator from the recalled Safe & Green 32 oz. Fuel bottle and reinstall the child-resistant closure that was included with the product’s original packaging. If the child-resistant closure is not readily available, consumers should immediately secure the recalled Safe & Green 32 oz. fuel bottle out of the sight and reach of children. Consumers should contact Firefly Fuel for a free corrected label to put on the bottle and a free replacement child-resistant lid, if the original is missing.

Werner Recalls 20' and 24' Multi-Max Pro Multi-Purpose Ladders Due to Fall Hazard (Recall Alert)

Name of Product: Werner 20' and 24' Multi-Max Pro Multi-Purpose Ladders

Hazard: The ladders' locking mechanism can jam and not fully lock into place, posing a fall hazard.

Description: This recall involves the Werner 20' and 24' Multi-Max Pro multi-purpose ladder. The ladders were sold in silver with a blue top and a blue label on the side rail. The label includes an oval containing the word "Werner" next to the words "MULTI MAX PRO" along with the size and model number ALMP-20IAA or ALMP-24IAA. The ladders also have a long black rope in the back section.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled ladders and contact Werner to receive a full refund. Consumers should register at <http://www.wernerco.com/recalls> to receive details on how to dispose of the recalled ladder. Once disposal is complete, Werner will issue a full refund in the form of a check.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received 18 reports of falls, including 14 reports of injuries resulting in bruising, lacerations, head injuries and fractures to the wrist, leg and ribs.

Empower Brands Recalls Remington Hair Dryers Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Electrocutation and Shock Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 14 August 2025

Recall Number: 25-430

Name of Product: Hair Dryers sold under the “Remington” brand, model number D3190DCDN

Hazard: The handheld hair dryers lack an immersion protection device, which presents a substantial product hazard to consumers, posing the risk of death or serious injury from electrocution or shock if the hair dryers fall into water while plugged in.

Description: This recall involves Empower Brands’ Hair Dryers sold under the “Remington” brand, model number D3190DCDN. The hairdryers were sold in purple with black accents. There are three black-colored operating buttons on the hair dryer handles. “Remington” is written in white text on the side of the hair dryer. The product is about 8.5 inches long by 11.6 inches high by 3.6 inches wide and weighs approximately 1.5 pounds.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately unplug and stop using the recalled hair dryers and contact Empower Brands to receive a full refund. Consumers must submit a photo of the hair dryer with its power cord cut in half to the recall registration portal at <https://www.remingtonproducts.com/product-recalls> and follow the disposal instructions provided on the website.
