MEMORANDUM FOR All Fort Eisenhower Military and Civilian Personnel

SUBJECT: Garrison Commander's Policy Memorandum Number 11 - Prohibition of Self- Directed or Customer-Driven Activities in Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation Facilities

1. Reference: Army Regulation (AR) 215-1, Military Morale, Welfare, and Recreation Programs and Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities.
2. Purpose. To provide guidance on unauthorized activities in Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) facilities.
3. This policy applies to all DFMWR facilities except Child and Youth Services (CYS) facilities.
4. Unauthorized self-directed or customer-driven activities are prohibited within DFMWR facilities. For purposes of this policy letter, self-directed or customer-driven activities include, but are not limited to, card games, board games, dominoes, and other such games brought into DFMWR facilities by groups or individuals.
5. This policy does not apply to DFMWR sponsored events such as Bingo, Texas-Hold-Em Poker Nights, and sports leagues.
6. Exceptions to this policy must be approved in writing by the Director of Family & MWR or their designee.
7. The Business Operations Division, Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation is the proponent for this policy memorandum.
