Managing Your (MY) Transition and MOC Crosswalk 0800-0900; 0900-1100	Oct 6, 16, 20, 27E , 28 Nov 3, 17E , 18 Dec 1, 8	ITP Overview/Translate military skills, training and experience into civilian skills, education and credentialing. These are two separate classes.
Financial Planning 1200-1600	Oct 6, 16, 20, 27E , 28 Nov 3, 17E , 18 Dec 1, 8	Assists in identifying financial responsibilities, obligations and goals after transition from active duty.
DOL Employment Fundamentals of Career Transition (EFCT) 0800-1600	Oct 7, 14, 21, 28E Nov 4, 18E Dec 2, 9	A 1-day class that provides an overview of employment topics and best practices in the civilian sector.
Continuum of Military Service 1100-1130	Oct 3, 17, 24, 31 Nov 7, 14, 21 Dec 5, 12	Informs service members of the opportunity to continue their military service by joining the Army Reserve Components. <u>Retirees are exempt from this presentation.</u>
VA Benefits and Services 0800-1600	Oct 3, 14, 17, 24, 31E Nov 7, 14, 21E Dec 5, 12	Introduces troops to benefits they may be eligible for and connects them with available resources.
DOL Employment Workshop 0800-1600	Oct 1-2 Nov 5-6 Dec 3-4	A 2-day workshop designed to assist with planning and executing successful job searches, résumé writing and interviewing skills.
