**MEMORANDUM FOR All Fort Eisenhower Personnel**

**SUBJECT: Garrison Commander's Policy Memorandum Number 16 - Authorized Bingo Players**

**1. References:**

a. Army Regulation (AR) 215-1, para 8-12, C 1-4.

2. This policy applies to any authorized user requesting to play bingo, to include their guests.

3. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to establish who is authorized to play bingo on Fort Eisenhower.

4. Procedure: The Garrison Commander may impose additional local restrictions for authorized users.

a. Authorized patrons and bona fide guests may play.

b. Volunteers serving as callers or monitors, Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) activity managers, Director, Family and MWR, direct-line supervisors, employees working the bingo activity, and their immediate family members may not play.

c. Family and MWR employees not previously specified may play.

d. The following personnel and their immediate family members may not play:

(1) Cyber Center of Excellence Commanding General, Deputy Commander, and/or Command Sergeant Major.

(2) Garrison Commander, Deputy to the Garrison Commander, and/or Garrison Command Sergeant Major.
