Dearlomum Retractable Safety Gates Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death to Children from Entrapment Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-385

Name of Product: Dearlomum Retractable Safety Gates

Hazard: The recalled gates violate the federal standard for expansion gates and expandable enclosures because a child's torso can fit through the opening between the gate and the floor, posing a risk of serious injury or death due to entrapment hazard.

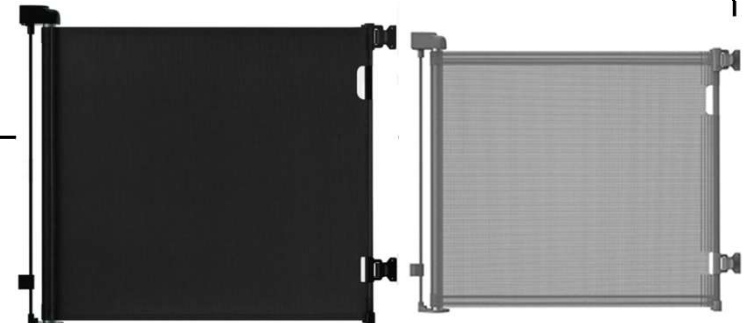
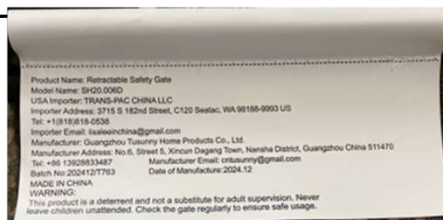

Description: This recall involves Dearlomum retractable mesh safety gates, sold in black, gray and white. The gates have a metal frame, and measure about 33 inches high with an adjustable width up to 55 inches. "Retractable Safety Gate" and model number "SH20.006D" are printed on a white label on the side of the gate.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the recalled gates immediately and contact Signbaby for instructions to receive a full refund. Consumers will be asked to disassemble the gates and destroy them by cutting the mesh and to send a photo of the destroyed gates to regcards.team@gmail.com. Once the photo is received, Signbaby will issue a full refund. Signbaby and Amazon are contacting all known purchasers directly.

AUGNORYE Padded Crib Bumpers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Suffocation (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-384

Name of Product: AUGNORYE Padded Cushioned Crib Bumpers

Hazard: The recalled padded cushioned crib bumpers violate the federal crib bumper ban because they can obstruct an infant's breathing, posing a suffocation hazard. This creates an unsafe sleeping environment for infants. Padded crib bumpers are banned by the Safe Sleep for Babies Act.

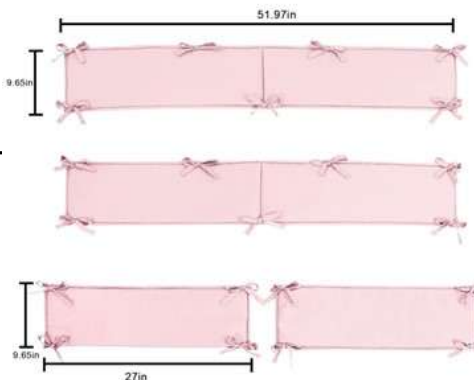

Description: This recall involves AUGNORYE padded cushioned crib bumpers. The polyester pink bumpers were sold in four pieces and measure approximately 27 inches by 9.6 inches, and 52 inches by 9.6 inches. There is a care label with a series of letters and numbers stitched to the crib bumper.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled padded cushioned crib bumpers and contact YIXIA for a full refund. Consumers should remove the crib bumpers, cut the straps and padding and email a photo of the destroyed bumpers to Yixiakejirecall@163.com to obtain a full refund. YIXIA and Amazon are contacting all known purchasers directly.

Braided Crib Bumpers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Suffocation (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-383

Name of Product: Braided crib bumpers

Hazard: The recalled crib bumpers violate the federal ban on crib bumpers because the padded crib bumpers can obstruct breathing, posing a risk of serious injury or death to infants from suffocation. Padded crib bumpers are banned by the Federal Safe Sleep for Babies Act.

Description: This recall involves braided crib bumpers. They are sold in multiple colors and have sizes in 39 inches, 59 inches, 78 inches, 118 inches and 158 inches long. They come in a vacuum sealed bag. There are no markings or labeling on the crib bumpers.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the crib bumpers, remove them from the crib immediately and contact Haoyunm for a refund. Consumers should cut the bumper in half, take a photo of it, and email the photo to hyzhongtshung@outlook.com.

SPPTTY Kids Bicycles Recalled Due to Risk of Death or Injury from Lead Poisoning (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-382

Name of Product: SPPTTY Kids 14- and 18-inch Bicycles

Hazard: Multiple components of the children's bicycles contain levels of lead that exceed the federal lead content ban, posing a lead poisoning hazard to children. In addition, the black paint on the bicycle pumps contains lead that exceeds the federal lead paint ban. Lead is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health issues.

Description: This recall involves SPPTTY kids bicycles. The bicycles are pink with brown seat covers, brown handlebars, brown pedals and brown baskets and were sold in 14-inch and 18-inch sizes. The brand "SPPTTY" and "New Sport Bike" are printed on the downtube.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the recalled children's bicycles immediately and contact Shenzhen Yihuachuang Technology for a full refund. To receive a refund, consumers should dismantle the bicycles, take a photo, and send the photo by email to lishkjie@163.com. After submitting proof of destruction, consumers should dispose of the recalled bike.

Giant Bicycle Recalls Momentum Vida E+ E-Bikes Due to Crash Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-381

Name of Product: Momentum Vida E+ Bikes

Hazard: The fork steerer tube on the recalled bicycles can crack, break or separate during use, posing a fall hazard.

Description: This recall involves the Momentum Vida E+ E-bike. The bicycles come in metallic red, pearl white, metallic navy blue, metallic green, indigo blue, happy mint (light green) and panther (black). The bicycle comes in two frame configurations (mid-step and low-step) and both configurations come in small, medium and large sizes. The unique serial number for each bike is stamped into the frame on the outer side of the left rear dropout and on a printed sticker under the bike's downtube. “Momentum” is written on the downtube of the bicycle and “Vida E+” is written on the top tube.

Remedy: To determine whether a Momentum Vida E+ bicycle is included in this recall, consumers should look at the third character of the bike’s serial number. Bikes with a serial number in which the third character is “H”, “J” or “K” are included in this recall and must have their forks replaced free of charge. Bikes with a serial number in which the third character is “G” require additional visual inspection by an authorized Giant Bicycle dealer to determine fork status.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received four reports of broken fork steerer tubes. No injuries have been reported.

WLIVE Fabric Dressers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Tip-Over and Entrapment Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-380

Name of Product: WLIVE Fabric 15-Drawer Dressers

Hazard: The recalled dressers are unstable if they are not anchored to the wall, posing serious tip-over and entrapment hazards that can result in injuries or death to children. The dressers violate the federal standard as required by the STURDY Act.

Description: This recall involves WLIVE Fabric 15-Drawer Dressers. The tall dresser includes 15 fabric drawers with a frame and handles and was sold in rustic brown, black, charcoal black wood grain print, and white. The dresser is about 12 inches long by 40 inches wide by 51 inches tall and weighs approximately 36 pounds. The model number, "ASNG105", is printed on the side of the packaging box of the product.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled dressers if they are not anchored to a wall and place them in an area that children cannot access. Contact WLIVE for instructions on how to dispose of the dressers to receive a full refund. Consumers must submit a photo of the disposed dresser to wliveproductrecall@wlivehome.com. Creekllybear Play Yard Mattresses Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment Hazard (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Name of Product: Creekllybear “Pack and Play” Aftermarket Play Yard Mattresses

Hazard: The aftermarket play yard mattresses violate the mandatory standard for crib mattresses as the mattresses exceed thickness requirements and may not adequately fit certain play yards, posing a deadly entrapment hazard. Babies can suffocate in gaps between an undersized mattress, or extra padding, and side walls of a product, especially when the infant’s face becomes trapped against the side and the mattress, preventing the infant from breathing.

Description: This recall involves Creekllybear “Pack and Play” Aftermarket Play Yard Mattresses. The mattresses are white with grey striping and have “Play Mat” and “Model: m-sy2” printed on labels attached to the mattresses. The mattresses measure about 26 inches wide and 38 inches long.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the mattresses and contact Kbabyea for a full refund. Consumers should cut the mattresses in half and send a photo of the cut-mattress in the waste bin to Kbabyearecall@outlook.com to receive a full refund.

Walmart Recalls Ozark Trail 64 oz Water Bottles Due to Serious Impact and Laceration Hazards (Recall Alert)

Company Recall Date: 10 July 2025

Recall Number: 25-377

Name of Product: Ozark Trail 64 oz Stainless Steel Insulated Water Bottles

Hazard: The lid can forcefully eject, posing serious impact and laceration hazards, when a consumer attempts to open the capped bottles after food, carbonated beverages or perishable beverages, such as juice or milk, are stored inside over time.

Description: This recall involves Ozark Trail 64 oz Stainless Steel Insulated Water Bottles sold with model number 83-662 on the product packaging. The stainless-steel bottles are silver with a black one-piece screwcap lid. They measure 4.41 x 4.41 x 11.5 inches and there is an Ozark Trail logo embedded on the side of the bottle. The model number does not appear on the product.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled water bottles and contact Walmart for a full refund. Consumers can bring the bottle to their nearest Walmart store for a refund.

Incidents/Injuries: Walmart has received three reports of consumers who were injured when struck in the face by a lid forcefully ejected from these bottles upon opening. Two consumers suffered permanent vision loss after being struck in the eye.
