MEMORANDUM FOR United States Army Garrison Fort Greely, Alaska

SUBJECT: Command Policy #29 – Key and Essential Personnel

1. References:

2. The following positions within Fort Greely, Alaska, have been designated as key and essential:

- a. Garrison
 - 1. Commander
 - 2. Command Sergeants Major
 - 3. Battle Field Grade
 - 4. Chaplain
- b. 49th Missile Defense Battalion
 - 1. Commander
 - 2. Command Sergeants Major
- c. Fort Greely Army Medical Clinic
 - 1. Officer in Charge
 - 2. Chief Nurse Officer in Charge
 - 3. Senior Non-Commissioned Officer

- d. Cold Region Test Center
 - 1. Officer in Charge
 - 2. Senior Non-Commissioned Officer
- 3. Reference (a) requires that all key and essential positions be determined by the Garrison Commander to reside on the installation. It is expected, when possible, the individuals listed in paragraph 2 will reside on the installation when suitable housing is available.
- 4. Personnel assigned to a key and essential position who desire to live off the installation must submit an exception to policy through their Chain of Command to the Fort Greely Garrison Commander as authorized in Reference (b).
