


# How to get your Facebook Page Plug-in in Concrete5 (Screenshots are Fort Leavenworth Facebook)

**NOTE: Must do this in order:**

1. Open browser and log in to your official Facebook account.
2. Open NEW tab and copy/paste this URL:  
<https://developers.facebook.com/docs/plugins/page-plugin>
3. Scroll down to "Facebook Page URL". Make sure "https://www.facebook.com/**YOUR Facebook PAGE/**" is **CORRECT**.




**Step 3:** Place this code wherever you want the plugin to appear on your page.

## NOTE: Last step in Facebook

6. Click in Iframe code once (text will highlight) and copy / paste into a text editor (Notepad or Word).

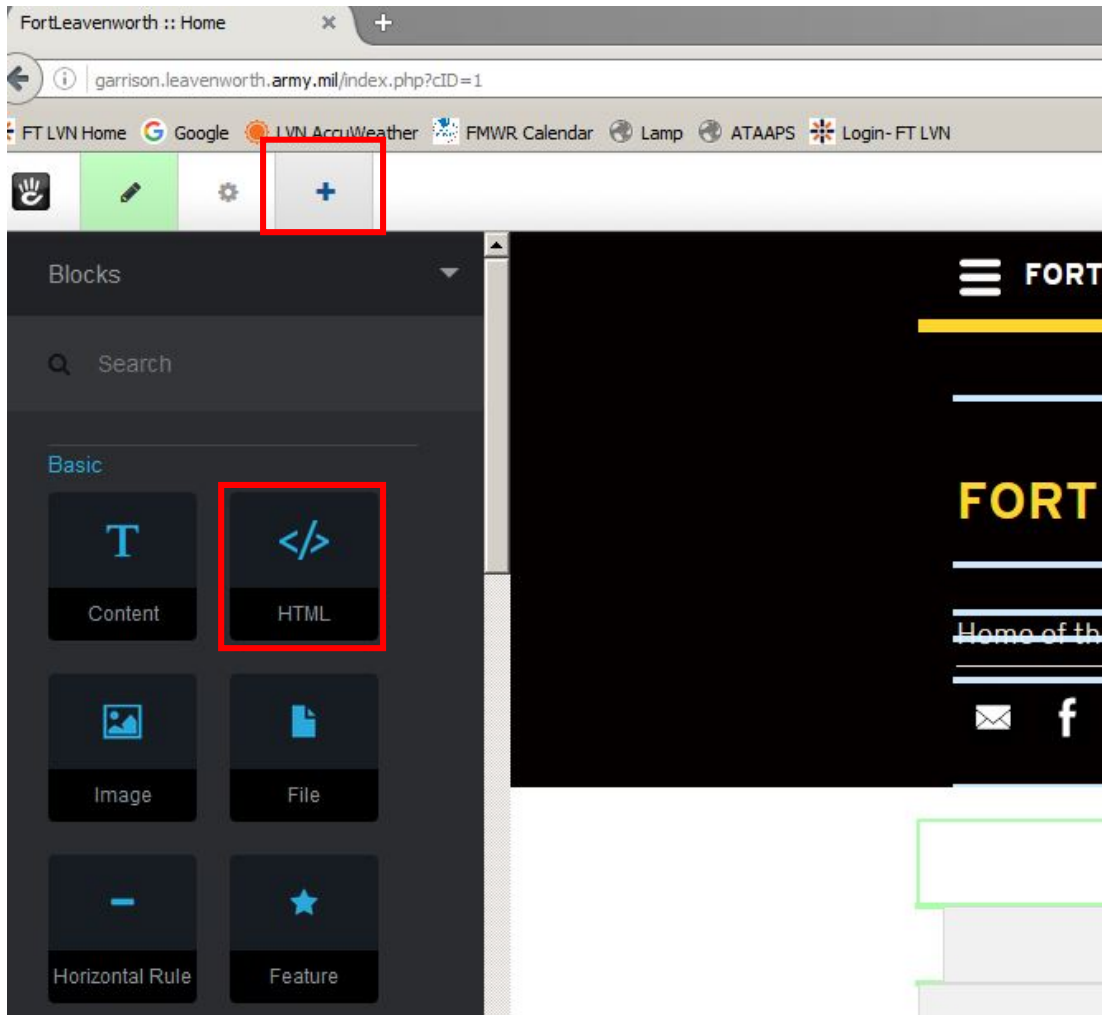

## How to get your Facebook Page Plug-in in Concrete5 (continued)

LOG-IN to Concrete5 CMS:

- Go to page you want the Facebook Page Plug-in to show (homepage).
- Click the plus sign (add content to the page) in the CMS toolbar.



- Click & drag the "HTML" block to where you want on the page.
- When the "Add HTML" pop-up window appears, copy/paste Facebook Page Plugin code into it. Save.
- You should see your Facebook Page Plug-in.
- Publish page.
