



Trusted Traveler Help Guide

**Effective as of
December 15, 2022**

Trusted Traveler allows valid DoD ID card holders to escort guests onto Fort Gregg-Adams without visitor passes from the Visitor Control Center.



Trusted Travelers are service members, adult dependents, DoD employees, and military retirees and their spouses – with valid DoD identification. All others are **ineligible** for the program, including: visitor card holders, volunteers, family care providers, foreign personnel, contractors, tow truck drivers, and taxi/shuttle/Uber/Lyft drivers (even with valid DoD identification) conducting duties for commercial purposes.



Trusted Travelers are limited to a single non-commercial vehicle with no more than 5 passengers.



Trusted Travelers with valid DOD identification may vouch for the vehicle occupants, but the driver's ID will always be scanned.



Trusted Travelers must remain with their guests for the duration of their stay on Fort Gregg-Adams.



Trusted Traveler hours are from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Who can serve as a sponsor?

YES

- Service members & dependents (18+)
- Military retirees & spouses
- DOD employees with a CAC

YES

Eligible ID cardholder riding as a passenger
(Driver ID also will be scanned)

NO

Contractor with a DOD ID card containing a green stripe.

NO

Other passes such as installation passes or U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs ID.

How many visitors can I sponsor?

YES

One non-commercial vehicle with no more than five passengers.

NO

One vehicle with six or more passengers.

Who can DoD ID card holders NOT sponsor?

NO

Personnel with a foreign passport.

NO

Taxi / shuttle / Uber or Lyft drivers conducting duties for commercial purposes.

NO

Individuals barred from Fort Gregg-Adams, VA.

Where can my guests go on post?

YES

Any non-restricted area when accompanied by the sponsor.

NO

Restricted areas with or without the sponsor.

NO

Any location unescorted by the sponsor.
