SUBJECT: No Loitering Policy

1. Reference: Army Regulation (AR) 190-13, The Army Physical Security Program, dated 27 June 2019.
2. Applicability. This policy applies to all Fort Hamilton community and civilian personnel.
3. Proponent. Directorate of Emergency Services, Fort Hamilton.
4. Fort Hamilton is a controlled access military installation. The presence of military personnel, equipment, and service missions requires enhanced security and access control measures in accordance with Department of Defense standards. IAW applicable regulations, it is necessary to maintain appropriate access to Fort Hamilton. In all circumstances, the Garrison Commander maintains the authority to deny access by any person or entity that may challenge the safety, security, well-being, or interests of those authorized to work, train, or conduct other activities on Fort Hamilton.
5. Access to Fort Hamilton and any of its facilities is for official business only. Visitors, upon completing their business, should leave the installation within a reasonable amount of time. Persons found to be loitering on the installation will be asked to leave and are subject to being escorted off the installation by anyone under the authority of this policy. Anyone found to be loitering, may be denied access to the installation on future occasions, should the circumstances warrant it. Anyone can notify installation Directorate of Emergency Services if they suspect anyone to be loitering.
6. A safe and secure workplace is necessary for a productive and successful environment. The entire installation must strive to ensure adherence to this policy.
