MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) Policy

1. References:

a. Army Regulation (AR) 190-13, The Physical Security Program, Chapter 11, Management and Use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems on or near Installation, dated 27 June 2019.

b. Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 2000.26, Suspicious Activity Reporting, Change 1, dated 12 May 2017.

c. Army Regulation (AR) 95-2, Air Traffic Control, Airfield/Heliport, and Airspace Operations, dated 31 March 2016.

d. 14 Code of Regulations (C.F.R.) Part 107.

2. Proponent. Directorate of Emergency Services (DES), Fort Hamilton.

3. In accordance with the above stated references, the use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS)/DRONES are prohibited on and over Fort Hamilton airspace.


4. Enforcement. Use of UAS/DRONES from within an installation may result in the loss of installation access privileges; potential forfeiture of any unauthorized recordings, photographs, or videos; adverse personnel action; and possible criminal prosecution under Federal or State law, as appropriate. Signs prohibiting UAS/DRONES have been posted at the installation entry points, Engledrum Bluff and on Taylor Field. Installation law enforcement officials will refer incidents involving unauthorized UAS/DRONE flights controlled outside of the installation to local law enforcement.

5. Training. DES DACP/DASG personnel will be trained annually on the identification and procedures involving UAS/DRONES.

6. Reporting. Suspicious UAS activity will be reported to the DES in accordance with DoDI 2000.26. The DES will make mandatory notifications and record the activity on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's eGuardian system.
