MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison Fort Hamilton Quiet Hours

- 1. Purpose: Establish "Quiet Hours" throughout the Fort Hamilton Community.
- 2. Scope: Applies to all military personnel, family members, guests, and civilians who reside in, or pass through, the Ft. Hamilton housing areas.
- 3. Policy: Quiet hours: 2200-0600, in the Fort Hamilton Community. Loud noises are prohibited during this time. Examples of activities that are prohibited include: mowing lawns, using power tools, hammering, wood working, allowing dogs to bark for extended periods, playing radios, TVs, or stereos at such a volume as to disturb others, conducting picnics or parties outside or on balconies, playing or practicing of unit athletic teams in the housing or picnic areas, riding toys and shouting, screaming or general roughhousing by individuals or groups.
- 4. There will be no cadence calling within 100 meters of family housing or residential areas. Physical training will not be conducted, other than passing through, in, or adjacent to family housing or residential areas.
- 5. The only exception to the Quiet Hours policy is the sounding of alarms in case of an emergency.
- 6. The establishment of the Quiet Hours policy does not imply that noise restrictions are non-existent during other times of the day. Excessive noise that disturbs neighbors is prohibited at all times.
- 7. Housing occupants, neighborhood and building coordinators are required to enforce the policy in a friendly and neighborly manner. The Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) will be called only when violators fail to respond to occupant and/or Balfour Beatty personnel suggestions for mitigation. DES will respond to correct the noise condition. All violations will be referred to Balfour Beatty for further administrative actions. For repeated violations, sponsors may be subject to adverse administrative action to include termination of their housing on the Installation.
