MEMORANDUM FOR: All Members of the USAG Fort Hamilton Community

SUBJECT: Commander's Solid Waste and Recycling Policy

- 1. Reference: Army Regulation 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement, 13 Dec 2007.
- 2. Intent: To establish a Fort Hamilton policy on waste reduction and recycling.
- 3. Applicability: This policy applies to Commanders, Soldiers, civilian employees, managers and supervisors stationed at Fort Hamilton.
- 4. The keystone to the success of the recycling program is the attitude and support of leaders, Soldiers and civilians. Accordingly:
- a. Commanders and civilian managers are directly responsible for effective implementation of their organization's recycling programs.
- b. Fort Hamilton has an effective Building Managers program. The Building Manager of every facility will actively seek new opportunities for waste reduction and recycling in his or her facility.
