K. OCP Patrol Cap (w/ rank and name tape) No boonie caps are authorized	L. Boots, Tan Leather (IAW AR 670-1)
M. Waterproof bag, military issue (not required to be taped/marked for Day Zero)	N. Pens x2
O. Leather work glove with an additional friction bearing pad of doubled leather that covers the entire palm (gloves will be used for rappelling operations). <i>*See Lightning Academy website, Air Assault packing list for pictures of authorized and unauthorized gloves.*</i>	P. DAY ONE – DAY 10 (FIRST MONDAY OF THE COURSE UNTIL GRADUATION)

Day 1 through Day 10 of Air Assault School. This packing list is also known as the "Rucksack Packing List". Each Student will maintain and be prepared to lay out the following items for the duration of the Air Assault Course, starting Day 1.

I. OCP/IHWCU Top x 2 (as worn ie. flag, U.S. Army, name tape, unit patch, rank)	J. OCP/IHWCU Bottom x 2 (serviceable)
K. PT Shirt Issued (short sleeve) No unit shirts.	L. PT Shorts (serviceable, ie. US Army not faded)
M. Brown Towel x 2	N. Patrol Cap w/ name and rank
O. Wet Weather Gear (top & bottom)	P. T-Shirt, Tan / Tan 499 x 2 No markings on shirt
Q. Glove Inserts x 1 pair	R. AA Handbook (issued)
S. Leather work glove with an additional friction bearing pad of doubled leather that covers the entire palm (gloves will be used for rappelling operations). <i>*See Lightning Academy website, Air Assault packing list for pictures of authorized and unauthorized gloves.*</i>	T. L-shaped Flashlight (red lens only—must be operational)

Y. Socks x 3 pair (green/tan/black)	Z. Reflective Belt IAW Unit SOP
