



Pedestrian Safety

- 19 total vehicle/pedestrian accidents between 2018 – 2021.
- In 8 of the accidents, pedestrians were transported to the hospital.
- FY23 Pedestrian Accidents: 7 (*one in crosswalk)



Avoid cell-phone usage in crosswalk.

Hawaii State Code 291C-72/74 Pedestrian Crossing

- **Duties of the pedestrian:** No pedestrian shall suddenly leave the curb and walk/run into the path of a vehicle which is so close that it is impossible for driver to yield.
- **Duties of the Driver:** Exercise due care to avoid colliding with any pedestrian upon roadway and shall give warning by sounding horn and shall exercise precaution upon observing any child / incapacitated person on roadway.

Abandoned Vehicles



- Operation Clean Sweep during spring clean up 15-19 May
- Notify military police of any vehicles that appear to be derelict or abandoned.

Crime Prevention

- There is an increase in property crimes on USAG-HI installations. In several cases, residential doors, windows or vehicles were left unsecured.
- Safety reminder to secure your property (lock residential doors, windows, and vehicles)

Prior to Arrival

- Complete all required medical appointments as directed by unit
- Obtain enough prescription medication to cover the PCS timeline
- Ensure EFMP screening is completed and e-EFMP is up to date

Upon Arrival

- Call TRICARE West at 1-888-866-9378 to inform them of your PCS and to be assigned a local Primary Care Manager (PCM)
- Even if you are coming from another TRICARE West location, you still must call

New Dependents

- New dependents must be registered in DEERS before being enrolled in TRICARE. Newborns have 90 days for DEERS enrollment.
- After DEERS registration, contact TRICARE West to receive a local PCM 1-888-866-9378



School Paperwork

- The Hawaii Department of Education requires an annual physical and a tuberculosis screening for all students.
- If your child has had a physical within the last 9 months, the Family Medicine Clinic can transcribe that exam onto the required DoE form without requiring a new physical exam. Please send your provider a message through the MHS Genesis Patient Portal to initiate this process.
- If your child requires immunizations, you can walk-in to our Family Immunizations Clinic (Building 682, down the hall from main Pharmacy) M/T/W/F from 8 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. & 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. and Th from 8a.m. – 11:30 a.m.
- The Family Immunizations Clinic can complete the tuberculosis screening form for you on a walk-in basis.

Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.
