





Parents: Register your children through Parent Central Services, to ensure your provider is certified. If in doubt, call your local CYS office. Report violations to CYS immediately.

Army CYS Policy: If you provide more than ten hours of on-post childcare a week and have not been certified as a Family Child Care Provider, you may be in violation of your Housing Lease Agreement and could be jeopardizing the safety and well-being of children. Contact CYS to start the certification process to become a Family Child Care Provider.

1. Each contestant must sign a waiver and release form.
2. The contest is a series of rounds with participants able to withdraw at any stage during the round or before the next one begins.
3. The hot peppers will begin at a mild heat and increase with each round.
4. Each contestant will receive a single hot pepper in each round.
5. Contestants will be required to eat the entire pepper: flesh, seeds and membrane.
6. Contestants will be allowed to finish any pepper remaining in their mouth when time is called after one minute.
7. The winner will be determined by being the last remaining contestant willing to continue to the next round.
8. If there is a tie after the final round, remaining contestants will enter a "Lightning Round" where the contestant who eats the most peppers in 30 seconds is the winner.

 - Valid government ID card
 - Valid state registration and license plate sticker
 - Valid state safety inspection papers and stickers
 - Valid proof of insurance Hawaii "No Fault" insurance card
 - Post vehicle registration form



Illegal Parking

****USARHAW 190-5; Parking is authorized between two white painted parking lines on streets and in parking lots.**

Prohibited Parking includes; in a crosswalk, against the flow of traffic, next to a vehicle parked parallel to the curb, on grassed or seeded areas, within 20 feet of a fire hydrant, and any location outside of two white painted lines designating authorized parking.






Get a Kit

- State siren and installation giant voice system



- How do I schedule my second dose?**
We recommend scheduling your COVID-19 vaccines at www.operationcovidshot.com.
- Why aren't there any open appointments on www.operationcovidshot.com?**
There are currently no open appointments for COVID-19 vaccines at Tripler Army Medical Center, Desmond Doss Health Clinic, or Naval Health Clinic Hawaii due to a reduced vaccine supply. We will open appointments as we receive a resupply of the vaccine.
- How will I know when you receive more vaccines so I can schedule my appointment?**
Please continue to check the individual MTF social media sites or www.operationcovidshot.com for the most up to date information, including available appointments.
- Do I need to contact Tripler Army Medical Center, Desmond Doss Health Clinic, or Naval Health Clinic Hawaii to book my second appointment?**
No, you do not need to contact an MTF to book an appointment for your vaccine. We recommend you book your appointments on www.operationcovidshot.com. Please continue to check our individual MTF social media sites or www.operationcovidshot.com for the most up to date information, including available appointments.
- What about the vaccine timeline? Will I get my second dose in time?**
The CDC recommends 21-42 days between doses, which provides a wide window for scheduling your second appointment with no reduction in efficacy. Individuals who received a cancellation notice will be prioritized for a vaccine once we receive a resupply.
- Do I have to get my second dose at the same place I received my first dose?**
We highly recommend booking your second vaccine at the same facility where you received your initial dose. This allows us to better predict demand at each location and appropriately allocate vaccine supply across the platforms.
- When will children under the age of 16 be able to receive the vaccine?**
Research regarding the safety and efficacy of the vaccine for patients under 16 years of age is ongoing. Therefore, we are not currently vaccinating children under 16 years old. Please continue to check our Facebook pages and www.operationcovidshot.com for changes to this policy.

Unauthorized Child Care Ten Hour Rule – You Can Still Be Neighborly

It's okay to be neighborly and the "ten hour rule" does not eliminate "good neighbor" favors!

Examples of occasional care that does not occur on a regular basis.

Regular basis means routinely for an extended period of time.

- You can host a sleepover in your home with your children's friends.
- You can care for your neighbors children in your home overnight as a favor while they enjoy a weekend get-away.
- You can care your friend's children while they attend an appointment.
- You can be on a Family Care Plan for a friend or family member and provide care for their children when they are called away for weekend training or temporary duty.

Unauthorized child care settings do not apply to care being provided to your children in your own home.



Child Supervision & Babysitting:

Home Alone

Birth to age 9: No

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 4 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 12-13: Yes, up to 6 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 14-15: Yes, but not overnight. No longer than 9 hours with ready access to adult supervision

Age 16-17: Yes, no more than two consecutive overnight periods with access to adult supervision



Unattended Outside

Birth to age 5: No

Age 6-9: Yes, if in a playground/yard w/ immediate access to adult supervision (to include being within sight and hearing distance). Children 6 years old and older are exempt from the "outside unattended" rule when walking to and from school, school bus stop, or CYS activity. Walk cannot be longer than 1 mile or cross a busy street.

Age 10-11: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in hourly. Adult must respond within 30 minutes or less to a child in crisis.

Age 12-13: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in via phone or in person every 2 hrs., must know child's location/activity, and respond within 1hr .










- Retirees should start 24 months before retirement
- Un-programmed losses need to begin ASAP
- Spouses eligible



DHR - Reassignment Office

- Process & Publish the Following:
 - ✓ PCS Orders
 - ✓ IPCOT/COT Travel Orders
 - ✓ Excess Leave Orders
 - ✓ Confinement Transfer Orders
 - ✓ Deletion or Deferment of Assignments- Non PSDR units
- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to 6 Months from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to:
usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Early Return of Dependents

- Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc.

Dependent Travel

- The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Space Available Travel

- Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transportation of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents

Student Travel

- An entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Soldiers stationed overseas (Hawaii) who are full time students attending an accredited college/university.
- One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station.
- Application should be submitted no later than 60 days

Final Out-Processing Procedures

- **In-Person:** Room 102, BLDG 750, Ayers Ave, Soldier Support Center
- **Online:** Brigade/Battalion S1 send the final clearance documents to the Out-Processing inbox. Once verified, the Out-Processing Center will validate and provide a final Out-Processing Stamp and return stamped clearance papers to the S1 for distribution to the Soldier


