In an effort to expand AER categories of assistance AERHQ has updated four existing categories and added two new categories of assistance:

### **Updated Categories**

- Dental Care for Dependents: 50/50 Loan/Grant and eliminated \$5K cap
- Child Car Seats
- Cranial Helmets
- Funeral for Dependent/Non-Dependent: Raised Cap from \$10K to \$15K for Dependent Spouse funeral expense
- Emergency Travel: No changes/further clarity and explanation of the category guidelines given





#### Personal Protective Equipment

The safety of the community is a priority of the DES. Army Regulation requires the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) while operating a motorcycle and motorcycle type vehicles however USARHAW Policy Letter 1 also mandates the use of PPE while operating bicycles, skateboard etc.

Bicycle helmets approved by the Consumer Safety Commission will be worn by all personnel, including Family members, who ride bicycles on USAG-HI installations. Wearing approved protective headgear is mandatory while using powered and non-powered scooters, skateboard, roller skates, and roller blades.

#### Vehicle Towing / Abandoned Vehicles

The DES continues to work with the contracting office and other agencies in order to develop a long term solution to the abandoned vehicle problem across our installations. This is an issue that affects not only USAG-HI, but the City and County of Honolulu. We appreciate your continued patience as we work diligently with our partners to resolve this matter.

#### **Speed Enforcement**

DES values the feedback that has been received in recent months regarding speeding in the community. Based on this feedback, targeted speed enforcement has led to over 374 citations written for speed related offenses in recent months.

The Assimilated Crime Act (18 USC 13) authorizes military police to enforce State traffic laws for all persons operating a vehicle on a military installation.

Army Regulation 190-5, allows installation commanders to implement installation specific policies regarding the operation of a motor vehicle.
