## *Spouse Reimbursement Program*

***State Licensure and Certification Costs for the Spouse of a Soldier Arising From a Permanent Change of Station. Effective Date: The policy found in Army Dir 2019-18 is effective retroactively to the date of the NDAA 2018 (12 December 2017)***

- Eligibility

- ✚ U.S. Regular Army, Army National Guard and Army Reserve Soldiers whose spouse require a State relicensing or recertification to continue their profession in a new place of residence pursuant to the PCS or permanent change of assignment of a sponsor from one State to another State
  - ✓ The Soldier is reassigned, either as a PCS or Permanent Change of Assignment, from a duty station in one state to a duty station in another state
  - ✓ The movement of the Soldier's dependents is authorized at the expense of the United States as part of reassignment, IAW the PCS orders
- ✚ *Qualified Relicensing Cost* – Term “*Qualified relicensing cost*” means cost, including examination and registration fees, that are imposed by the state of the new duty station to secure a license or certification to engage in same profession the Soldier's spouse engaged in while in the state of the original duty station and are paid or incurred by the Soldier or spouse to secure the license or certification from the state of the new duty station after the date on which the orders directing the reassignment are issued.





# Directorate of Human Resources

## ✓ Spouse Reimbursement Program

- **How do Soldiers apply for reimbursement?** *By visiting their unit S-1 and providing at a minimum, the following support documents*
  - ✚ Standard Form (SF) 1034
  - ✚ Copy of Permanent Change of Station orders
  - ✚ Copy of Spouse's previous state license and/or certification (*is **NOT** required to have held the license in the immediately preceding duty station state. So long as the spouse, while married to the soldier, held the license at any prior duty station state*)
  - ✚ Copy of new state license and/or certification (an approval letter from the certifying agency, which must include license number and date is acceptable)
  - ✚ Proof of fees paid for relicensing and/or recertification from current permanent duty station

**NOTE:** The Unit S-1 will ensure the soldier's name is on the SF 1034, not the spouse's; verify marriage to a civilian spouse through the interactive personnel electronics records management system (iPERMS)

- **Reimbursement**
  - ✚ Qualified relicensing costs provided to a soldier may not exceed the amount established by applicable law, \$1,000.
  - ✚ This is taxable income. DFAS will issue a separate W-2 during tax season and will be available on the Soldier's MyPay account

**IAW with the FY2020 NDAA, the authority to provide reimbursement expires on 31 December 2024**

## Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



### Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.

## *Dependent Support*

### Community Centers Offer:

- Free lawn care. Backyards can be added to the mow list during deployments, whether the service members spouse stays on island or goes home for a visit and will last until the service member returns. You are required to submit the service members orders along with tentative return date to your community center.
- If the service member's spouse decides to go home for a visit for a long duration of time, the spouse can request to authorize the community center teams to check on the home periodically to ensure no leaks are occurring in the home and to check the overall safety of the home. Please complete a notice of absence form and submit it to your community center.

- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to **6 Months** from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to:  
[usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil](mailto:usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil)
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

# DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

\*Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights\*
