





Command Sponsorship

Prior to Arrival

- Complete all required medical appointments as directed by the sponsor's losing unit
- Ensure EFMP screening is completed and paperwork is up to date

Upon Arrival

- Call TRICARE West to inform them of your PCS and to receive a local Primary Care Manager
- Even if you are coming from another TRICARE West location, you still must call

New Dependents

- New dependents must be registered in DEERS before being enrolled in TRICARE. Newborn 90 day TRICARE coverage exception to allow for DEERS enrolment
- After DEERs registration, contact Tricare West to receive a local Primary Care Managers. 1-888-866-9378

School Paperwork

- HI Dept. of Education requires a TB test and an annual physical for all students.
- If your child has had a physical within the last 9 months, the Family Medicine Clinic can transcribe that exam onto the required DoE form without requiring a new physical exam. Please send your provider a message through MHS Genesis to initiate this process.
- If your child requires immunizations, you can walk-in to our Family Immunizations Clinic (Building 682, down the hall from the Main Pharmacy) Mon., Tues., Wed., and Fri. from 8 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. & 1 p.m. – 3 p.m and Thurs. from 8 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.
- TB screening has been a requirement since 2008, though rarely does it require the actual test. The Family Immunizations Clinic can complete the TB test and fill out the screening form for you on a walk-in basis.

EFMP

- Email is best source for answering questions: usarmy.tripler.medcom-tamc.list.pe-efmp@mail.mil
- Prior to PCS, ensure EFMP enrollments are current by scheduling an appointment with your family member's Primary Care Manager.
- The PCM will update the DD Form 2792 and return to you for submission.
Review this form carefully and make sure:
 - Page 2 is signed
 - Page 3 demographics are completed
 - Page 2, Block 9 is signed
- Once reviewed, submit form:

COVID-19 Testing Updates

- On 25 April, the DDHC COVID-19 drive-through testing garage is closing as demand for testing continues to decline.
- If you need a COVID-19 test, send your provider a secure message via MHS Genesis or call the COVID Hotline (808-433-8102) to request an order for a test. A staff member will contact you to schedule your test.
- On 25 April, the Fort Shafter Flats testing site is reducing its hours of operation to Tuesday & Friday from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Pre-surgical and pre-procedural testing will be conducted on those days. Symptomatic patients requiring testing can receive a test at the TAMC Emergency Department.



Test Results

- Results are typically available within 24-48 hours, but patients may experience a slight delay if demand for COVID-19 testing increases. The fastest way to receive your results is through the MHS Genesis Patient Portal. If you do not have access to the Patient Portal, register for a DS login at <https://dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect>.
- We **CANNOT** provide test results or medical guidance through Facebook or Google Messenger.



At Home Test Kits

- At home tests are available in our clinics on a walk-in basis
- Simply ask the front desk at your respective clinic for test kits!
- Bluetooth may be required to receive test results.
- Tests still available at USPS.com for delivery to your home.

Pedestrian Safety

- 19 total vehicle/pedestrian accidents between 2018 – 2021.
- In 8 of the accidents, pedestrians were transported to the hospital.

Hawaii State Code 291C-72/74 Pedestrian Crossing

- **Duties of the pedestrian:** No pedestrian shall suddenly leave the curb and walk/run into the path of a vehicle which is so close that it is impossible for driver to yield.
- **Duties of the Driver:** Exercise due care to avoid colliding with any pedestrian upon roadway and shall give warning by sounding horn and shall exercise precaution upon observing any child / incapacitated person on roadway.

DHR - Total Army Sponsorship Program

- Sponsorship is **required** in order to process permanent change of station (PCS) orders to Hawaii and other regions.
- **Soldiers (E1-O6)**
 - ✓ Soldiers must log onto the Army Career Trackers Total Army Sponsorship Program to initiate DA Form 5434 and request a sponsor.
 - ✓ Units are required to assign a sponsor 120 days prior to report date.
- **Department of Army Civilians**
 - ✓ DA Civilians can fill out the PDF version of the DA Form 5434 and email it to their gaining organization.
- **ACS Sponsorship Classes**
 - Classes held every Thursday at 1200 hrs via MS TEAMS.
 - Required for all assigned sponsors and volunteers.





DHR - Reassignment Office

- Process & Publish the Following:
 - ✓ PCS Orders
 - ✓ IPCOT/COT Travel Orders
 - ✓ Excess Leave Orders
 - ✓ Confinement Transfer Orders
 - ✓ Deletion or Deferment of Assignments- Non PSDR units
- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to 6 Months from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to:
usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Helpful Information for Sponsors to Inform Incoming Personnel

- ✓ Minimum age for tobacco and e-cigarette sales in Hawaii: **21 years of age.**
- ✓ Fines for using mobile electronic devices while driving: **\$250 (\$300 in school or construction zones)**
- ✓ Distracted walking in Honolulu: it is illegal to look at a mobile electronic device while crossing the street.
 - **First offense: \$35 fine**
 - **Second offense: \$75 fine**
 - **Third offense: \$99 fine.**
- ✓ No drinking is permitted in any public park (including beach parks), with a **fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both.**
