The garrison commander and/or the U.S. Army Hawaii senior commander attends and supports the meetings, along with garrison subject-matter experts and directors.



- ✓ **\$28,648 was provided back to Soldier's through unit funds in Fiscal Year 2019.**
- ✓ **Tap into your Fiscal Year 2020 Unit Funds!**
- ✓ **Each unit is allocated \$3.00 per Soldier per Unit.**
- ✓ **With every new fiscal year comes a new batch of unit funds. Use this money for any approved unit-wide morale event like an organization day, holiday party, or unit ball! Accessing your account is easy:**
 - Turn in your Assumption of Command, DA Form 1687, and AAA-162 (signed by Commander) to activate your account for FY20.
 - After you've planned out how you want to use the money, submit a request for funds at least 10-15 days before your event (10 days when less than \$500 and 15 days if more than \$500).
 - Upon approval, purchase approved items for your event. Return all receipts and any unused funds after your event.
- ✓ **Funds will not carryover beyond 30 September 2020.**

- Military members who knowingly allow unauthorized child care in their quarters may be subject to discipline under the UCMJ or adverse administrative action under U.S. Army Hawaii Regulation 1.
- Offenses could result in debarment (losing installation access and privileges) from US Army Hawaii military installations.
 - Major Violations of the Resident Occupancy Agreement or the “Island Palm Communities Resident Guide & Community Standards Handbook” of a serious nature may result in immediate eviction.

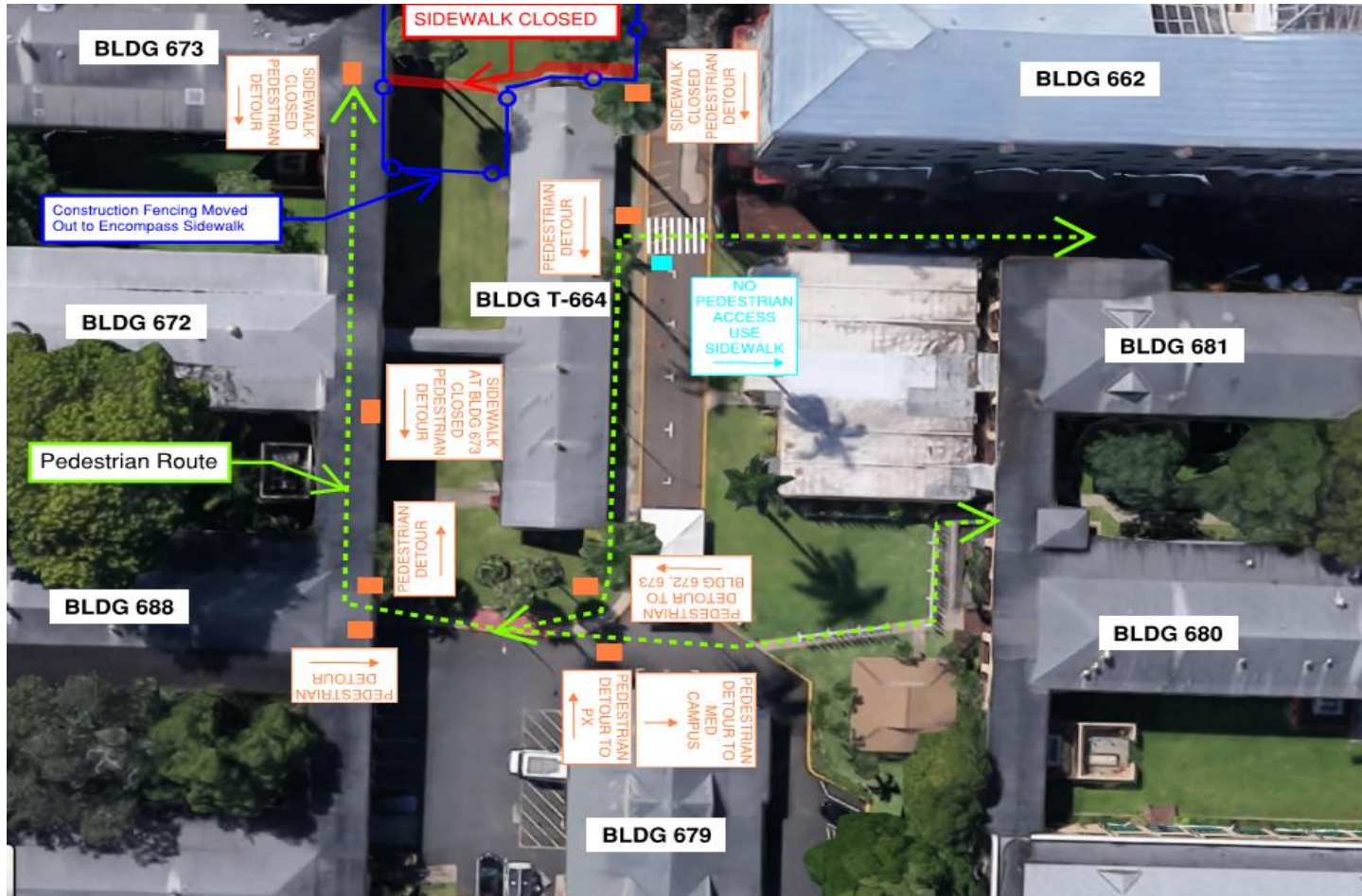

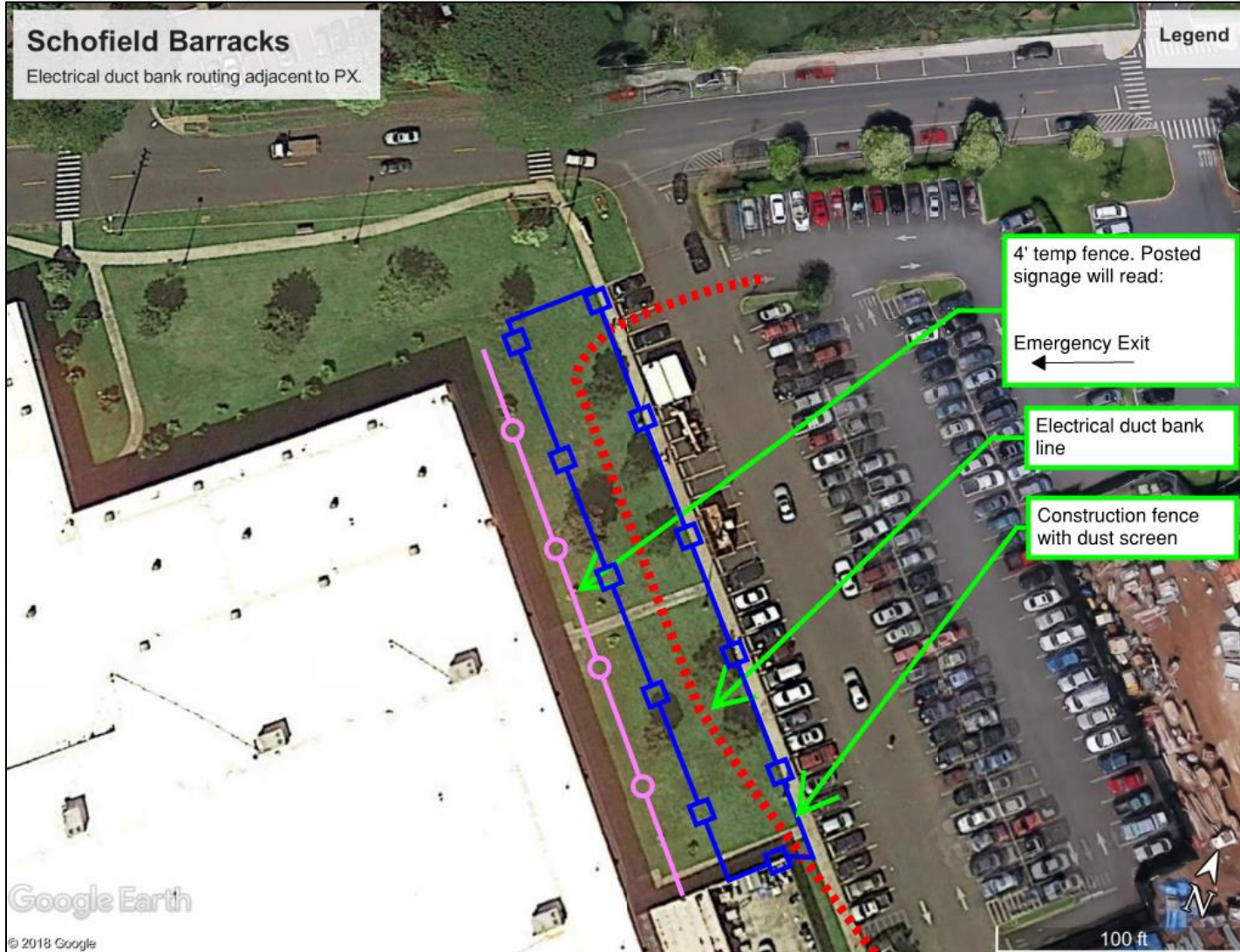

Plea to Commanders

- Please assist us by tracking your Soldiers' vehicles through in/out processing and when they receive their U.S. Military Non-Resident Certificate tax exempt forms.

Alternate Ways to Dispose of Unwanted Vehicles

- Donate your vehicle (charitable, tax-deduction, most charities will pick up the vehicle)
- Use the USAG HI Privately Owned Vehicle (POV) Resale Lot

Proper Procedures to Sell Your Vehicle

- In the State of Hawaii, vehicle owners must complete and submit a Notice of Transfer form when selling to a Private Party within 10 days of the transfer or sale.
- If you sell your car but do not file a completed Notice of Transfer with the Motor Vehicle, Licensing & Permits Division, you may be held financially responsible for fees, fines, and even accidents that occur after the sale.

Disabling Smoke Detectors

According the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 2019:

- Smoking materials caused 5% of reported home fires, 21% of home fatalities, 10% of home fire injuries, and 6% of the direct property damage to the home.
- **Smoke detectors are a primary defense** against unwanted fires caused by smoking material!
- Smoking and or the use of electronic (e-cigarettes/vaping) smoking devices is **prohibited in the barracks.**
- Tampering or disabling smoke detectors in the barracks is a violation of U.S. Army Regulation and unsafe!
- **Think Safety for yourself and others!**
